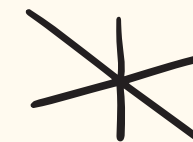

I'm thirsty

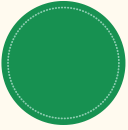
● **Estoy cansado/a**

I'm going to sleep

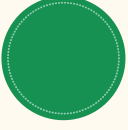
● **Gracias por la comida**
Thank you for the food

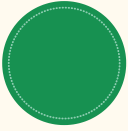
● **Voy a salir**

Where is the bathroom?

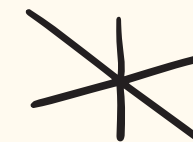
 **Necesito ayuda**

I have a meeting at 10 am

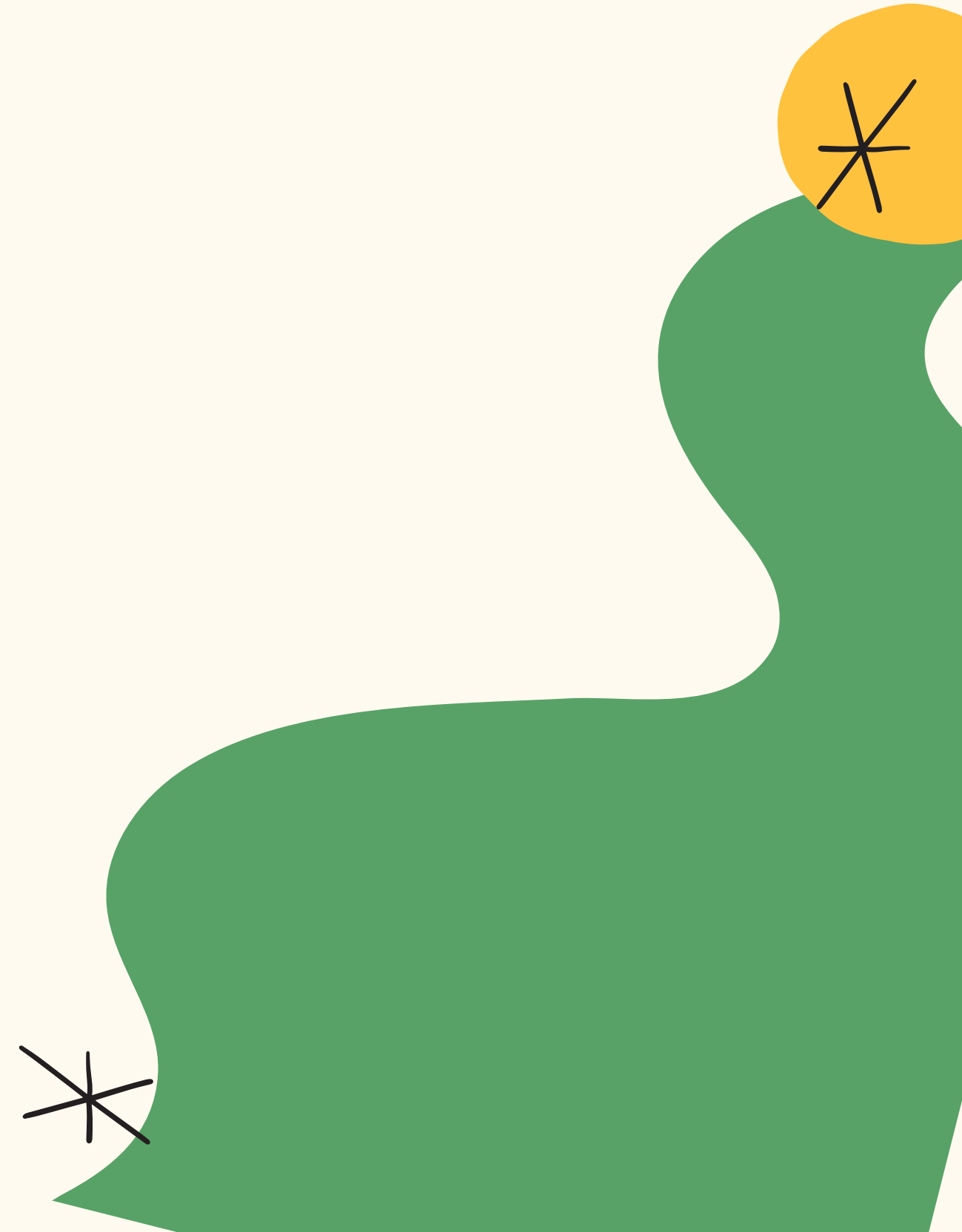
● **¿Puedes ayudarme con esto?**

How much does it cost?

● **Mi vuelo está atrasado**

My flight is late

● **¿Cuánto cuesta un boleto a [destino]?**

How much is a ticket to [destination]?

● **¿A qué hora sale el vuelo?**

What time does the flight leave?

● **¿Puedo pedir el menú, por favor?**

Can I see the menu, please?

● **La cuenta, por favor**

The bill, please

● **¿Dónde está el hotel?**

Where is the hotel?

● **Necesito un taxi**

I need a taxi

● **¿Puede darme la dirección, por favor?**

Can you give me the address, please?

● **¿y tú?**
and you?

● **¿Cuántos años tienes?**
How old are you?

● **Tengo años**
I have years

Tips for learning Spanish quickly

Immerse yourself in the language:

- **Listen to music and podcasts in Spanish:** Find genres and shows you enjoy. Try to understand the lyrics and content.
- **Watch movies and series in Spanish:** Start with subtitles in your language, then switch to Spanish subtitles, or turn them off completely.

Practice regularly:

- **Talk with native speakers:** Look for language exchange programs online or in your local community.
- **Join conversation groups:** Many cities have language exchange meetups.

- **Keep a journal:** Write daily about your day, thoughts, or any topic of interest.
- **Record yourself speaking:** Listen to identify mistakes and improve.
- **Private tutors:** Consider private lessons for personalized attention.

Be patient and consistent:

- **Set realistic goals:** Define short and long-term objectives to stay motivated.
- **Practice every day:** Even if only for a few minutes, daily practice is key to progress.

Learning a new language is a journey, and each small effort brings you closer to fluency.
