

If you are applying for a FIA Grade B or A license and you have not been issued this Grade in the past year, please see the information below for the additional information you will need to provide.

NOTE: FIA Language below are EXCERPTS (for the full language, please refer to Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code).

FIA Grade A and B Licensure, Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code

IMSA Applicants for new FIA Grade A Licenses must provide the following materials:

Copies of the Series' official documents for three (3) preceding seasons' race results showing the following information for championships listed in the table below:

- **Number of races in the championship.**
- **Date of each race.**
- **Track for each race.**
- **Number of cars starting each race.**
- **Driver's finishing position in each race.**
- **Driver's finishing position in the Championship season.**
- **Name(s) of any co-drivers (if applicable).**

IMSA Applicants for new FIA Grade B Licenses must meet the following criteria (and may be required to provide supporting information):

- The driver's ASN must ascertain that the applicant is over 18 years old and the driver must also be observed to compete satisfactorily in at least 10 national or international ASN-sanctioned circuit races for cars within the two years prior to application.

Or

- The driver must hold a C licence and must also be observed to compete satisfactorily in at least 7 national championship or international races. The minimum age under Article 1.2, Chapter I of Appendix L must be respected.

Or

- The applicant has finished among the top three in the final classification of a CIK World Championship or CIK World Cup. The minimum age under Article 1.2, Chapter I of Appendix L must be respected.

IMSA Applicants for renewals of FIA Grade A or B Licenses must provide verification as listed in 4.4:

- **4.4 In order to maintain the qualification for a Grade A or B license, the driver must participate in at least one international competition of the appropriate category per 12-month period, or otherwise must again be observed, to the satisfaction of the licensing ASN, during practice for an international competition.**

Grades of the FIA driver's licence and the competitions, including historic competitions, for which they are required and valid (NB: not applicable to drag racing):

- Super licence: required for the Formula One World Championship for Drivers.

- Grade A: required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio less than or equal to 1 kg/hp.
- Grade B: required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio of between 1 and 2 kg/hp, and the FIA WTCC Championship.
- Grade C: required for all cars with a Weight/Power ratio of between 2 and 3 kg/hp(except those mentioned above) and required for FIA Autocross, Rallycross and Truck Championships. Required also for Historic Formula One cars (Period G onwards), Formula Two cars (Period H onwards), Indy Cars (Period G onwards), Formula 5000 and Formula A cars (all), Group C cars (all), CanAm cars (all) and Sports Prototypes over 2 litres (Period G onwards) regardless of weight/power ratio.

Qualification for Grades A and B • FIA Grade A or B licences are issued by the driver's ASN, after it has verified that the driver's results, competence and conduct are satisfactory.
