ADMISSION PHASE

Necessary Information
or steps to take for your
Admission :

- 1) the eligibility of foreign students;
- 2) the available programs;
- 3) the deadlines for admissions;
- 4) the application file;
- 5) tuition fees in Romania;
- 6) cost of living and accommodation;
- 7) Visa for studying in Romania.

Here's How The Admission Process Works

- **Choice of university:**

Depending on your field of study you should choose a host university and prepare your application in accordance with that university.

- **Constitution of the application file:**

Your file must be prepared in accordance with your host university. The forms and other elements of your file must therefore conform to it.

- **Submission of the application file:**

Your file will be evaluated according to the host university's criteria. The university will request and obtain a letter of acceptance from the Ministry of Education.

- **Obtaining the letter of acceptance/attestation of recognition (for Europeans):**

Generally, if you are admitted by the university, obtaining the letter of acceptance is a formality. This letter will help you in the rest of your procedures (especially for obtaining a study visa in Romania).

Attention...

This phase is done with respect of:

- **A calendar / Deadlines**

Registration begins in the middle of the academic year in APRIL and ends in JULY each year. Applications are processed on a FIFO (First In First Out) basis.

- **Processing fees or file evaluation**

There is often a processing fee for the pre-registration file that varies between €50 and €250. Registration fees vary from 50€ to 100€.

- **Tuition fees**

Tuition fees vary from 2000€ per year to 3500€ per year in fields such as Economics, Law, Politics, Polytechnics, Medicine on average 7500 €/year and Conservatory and Architecture more than 9500€ per year.

An application file is required and contains the following documents:

- Simple copy of passport (pages 1, 2, 3 and 4) valid for at least 9 months after the date of acceptance to study;
- Certified copy of birth certificate or legalized translation if the original is not in a European language such as English, French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese etc.);
- Medical certificate from the country of origin or residence;
- Photo of identity format;
- Certified copy of bachelor's degree or equivalent/master's degree if necessary or legalized translation if the original is not in a European language;
- Certified copy of the transcript of the Baccalaureate and/or Bachelor's degree or legalized translation if the original is not in a European language ;
- Certified copy of the transcripts for all the classes of the high school/university cycle completed in copies or legalized translations if the original is not in a European language.

Letter of Acceptance

This is to certify that the study documents presented by Mr. KASONGO TSHIBANDA ANACTET from DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO born at 17.06.1998 entitle him to enter the Romanian educational system in the preparatory year for undergraduate studies in the field of Medicine, beginning with the academic year 2022-2023.

The enrolment is possible at the University „Titu Maiorescu” of Bucharest.

The annual fee is 3300 Euro and must be paid, in free currency, in advance in the account of the university RO65 BTRL 0430 4202 N018 16XX.

It might be subject to eventual changes.

Any other expenses (board, lodging, etc.) are to be covered personally. Please note that you need to prove at the entry in Romania that you have at least 2500 USD.

This approval is valid only on condition that, at arrival, the following documents are submitted:

- Original of the study documents certified by competent authorities of the issuing country.
- Those who apply for Ph.D. studies or for recognition of partial studies have to annex authorized copies of the correspondent curricula and syllabuses, as well.
- Authorized translation of the study documents.
- Certificate of birth (authorized translation).
- Medical certificate.
- Passport having the specific visa for studies in Romania.

If you will not realize the enrolment to study latest in term of 30 days since your arrival in Romania, the amount of fees paid in advance will be used to cover the expenses for your return in the home country.

The Romanian authorities may impose additional public health requirements. Romanian universities may also decide specific measures as regards the teaching and learning process in accordance with the public health guidelines.

ENROLMENT PHASE

Here's how the
Enrolment process
works

- Preparation of the visa application file:

Non-European students must apply for an entry visa to Romania for studies. This file must consist of:

Documents to be obtained in Romania such as: - Letter of Acceptance; - Proof of Payment of the tuition fee for one year; - Proof of Accommodation in Romania and

Documents to be obtained in your country of residence such as - vaccination record; - criminal record; - bank statement with the substance of €4000; - Passport and - Proof of Home Address; without forgetting the fees for certification of your file at the Romanian Embassy and the visa fee of €150.

- Constitution and Submission of the registration file:

When you arrive in Romania you will have to complete your registration file with a medical certificate from Romania and pay the medical certificate and the registration fee before submitting your original file.

- Constitution and filing of the application for a residence permit:

After your registration, you must now prepare and submit your application for a residence permit: this includes opening a bank account and getting a Lease Agreement.

Attention...

this phase involves:

- **A registration fee:**

There is often a processing fee for registration which also varies between €100 and €250.

- **A proof of substance:**

There is a proof of substance to present which must be done through a bank account processing fee of €4000.

- **An address of residence:**

You must obtain a lease agreement from your landlord (this can be the campus manager of your university or a private landlord). The rent varies from 150 to 600 euros depending on whether you are staying on campus, in a studio or an apartment.

Immigration Office.*
