NOTICE OF TRANSITION TO ONLINE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE ATTESTATION SERVICES

The Kenya Medical Practitioners and Dentists Council wishes to inform all stakeholders that it is transitioning from the manual attestation of medical certificates to a fully online attestation system.

The transition phase will run from **20th July to 31st July 2026**, with **full implementation taking effect on 3rd August 2026**. From this date, **all medical certificate attestations will be processed exclusively through the online platform**.

The online attestation service will only be available through the online service practitioner portal to **licensed medical practitioners who are in good standing with the Council**.

This transition will:

- Strengthen ownership and accountability in the medical certification process.
- Improve accessibility for practitioners and patients.
- Enhance efficiency through faster processing of attestation requests.
- Advance KMPDC's commitment to digitising and automating its services for greater transparency, reliability and service excellence.
