ADIMISSION, PROCEDURE

Here is how the admission process works

- Choice of university:

"Depending on your field of study you should choose a host university and prepare your application file in accordance with that university."

- Constitution of the admission file:

"Your file must be compiled in accordance with your host university. The forms and other elements of your application file must therefore comply with it".

- Submission of the admission file:

"Your application will be evaluated according to the criteria of the host university. The university will request and obtain a letter of acceptance from the Romanian Ministry of Education".

- Obtaining the letter of acceptance / attestation of recognition (for Europeans):

"Generally, if you are admitted by the university, obtaining the letter of acceptance / attestation of recognition (for Europeans) is a formality. This letter will be useful for the rest of your procedures (especially for obtaining a study visa in Romania) for non-European candidates."

This is how the admission is made

Attention...

- The calendar / deadlines

Enrolment begins in the middle of the academic year in APRIL and ends in JULY each year.

Applications are processed according to the FIFO (First In First Out) system, i.e. first come, first served.

- Fees for the processing or evaluation of admission files

There is often a fee for processing or assessing the admission file, which varies between between 100 and 500 euros.

This stage is done with respect:

At the end of this stage you have to come to Romania, that means:

- preparing to come to Romania to register
- prepare your visa application for non-Europeans

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PRE-REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Necessary information or steps to go through for your pre-registration

- 1) the eligibility of foreign students;
- 2) the fields of study available;
- 3) deadlines for pre-registration;
- 4) the composition of the application file;

- 5) tuition fees in Romania;
- 6) cost of living and accommodation;
- 7) the visa for studying in Romania.

1) Who can study in Romania

- citizens of any European or non-European state with a valid passport
- holders of at least a bachelor's degree;
- your age or level does not matter.

2) Available fields of study

- medicine and pharmacy;
- legal sciences;
- economic sciences;
- polytechnics (computer science, telecommunications, mechanics, aeronautics, refrigeration, engineering, construction, etc.)
- agricultural sciences;
- political science,
- journalism;
- foreign languages
- history and geography;
- oil and gas;
- etc.

3) Admissions deadlines

- Admissions begin in the middle of the academic year in APRIL and end in JULY of each year.
- Applications are processed on a FIFO (First In First Out) basis.

4) Composition of the admission file

- Application forms;
 - Identity documents such as passport, identity card, birth certificate
- birth certificate;
- Documents relating to your state of health;
 - Documents relating to your previous educational background such as your baccalaureate diploma
- Documents relating to your previous educational background such as your baccalaureate diploma or its equivalent, transcript of marks, secondary school reports or university reports for those opting for postgraduate studies (master, specialisation, doctorate etc.);
- Proof of proficiency in the language of study (Romanian, English or French);
 - Photographs in identity format;
 - Photographs in identity format; etc.

5) Tuition fees/costs

- The academic year costs between 2300 and 10.000€ depending on the field of study and the Romanian language (preparatory) year between 2000 and 3500€ depending on the field of study;
- There is often an admission and registration processing fee of between €100 and €500;

6) Cost of living and accommodation

- You can make ends meet with between 150 and 300€;
- Campus rent is around 150€ per month.

In a flat you can have a rent between 200 and 500€ per month.

It should be mentioned that you are required to show a substance/guarantee of about 4.000€ in the form of a bank statement in your own name and this after you have first paid your tuition for one year at the time of the visa application and residence once in Romania. Remember that you must have a budget of 4.000€ + 3.000€, i.e. 7.000€, apart from expenses related to your trip such as your ticket, visa fees, legalization of your file at the Romanian embassy, etc.

Of course, the 4.000€ of substance / guarantee will really help you to make ends meet during the academic year in the form of accommodation and food expenses.

7) The visa to study in Romania

- the letter of acceptance;
- proof of payment of the tuition fee for one year (2300€ and 10.000€);
- proof of accommodation in Romania;
- Vaccination booklet;
- criminal record;
- bank statement with the substance / guarantee of about 4.000€;
- passport and proof of home address;
- not forgetting the fees for the certification of your file at the Romanian Romania and the visa fee of 150 dollars.

REGISTRATION

Here is how the registration is done

- Constitution of the visa application file:

As registration is only done once you have arrived in Romania, non-EU students must apply for a visa to enter Romania for studies.

This file must consist of the documents to be obtained in Romania, such as

- the letter of acceptance/attestation of recognition
- proof of payment of the tuition fee for one year
- proof of accommodation in Romania and documents to be obtained in your country of residence such as

- vaccination booklet, criminal record, bank statement with the substance of 4.000€,
- passport and proof of address, as well as the fees for the certification of your file at the Romanian Embassy
- and the visa fee of 150 dollars.

- Constitution and submission of the registration file:

When you arrive in Romania you will have to complete your registration file with a medical certificate from Romania and pay the registration fee before submitting the original file.

- Constitution and submission of the application for a residence permit:

"After your registration, you must now prepare and submit your application for a residence permit: this requires, in addition to the registration certificate, the opening of a bank account, a lease contract as well as the payment of consular fees and the issuance of a residence permit (approximately 200€).

Attention....

This phase involves...

- A registration fee

There is often a fee for processing the registration file, which also varies between 100 and 250 euros.

- A proof of substance

There is a proof of substance to be presented which must be done through a bank account bank account of €4,000.

- A residential address

You must obtain a lease agreement from your landlord (this may be the campus manager of your university or a private landlord).

The rent varies from 150 to 600 euros depending on whether you live on campus, in a studio or a flat.

At the end of this phase you must, within 2 months of your arrival in Romania, apply for your residence permit at the immigration office.

What will you get?

- Your admission (letter of acceptance)
- Accompaniment to obtain your visa
- Reception on arrival in Romania
