Individuals applying for scholarship for the CDA Credential 120 content hours (credit and noncredit routes) and/or CDA Credential assessment fee are required to have proof of high school diploma (or higher). **Use this form to document a high school diploma completed outside the United States. If you have completed ANY degree: Do not upload this form; Upload your final transcript (or [NACES](#) equivalency report if non-US college) to your OEC Registry account.**

Steps:

1. Complete and upload this form in your OEC Registry account: Education > Non-US High School Diploma Attestation. Be sure all fields are completed in Part 1, and only complete Part 2 if you are unable to get a copy of your high school diploma. Be sure to sign the Attestation section (**hard signature or DocuSign which shows date and timestamp**).
2. Separately upload a copy of your high school diploma to your OEC Registry account (Education > High school diploma / GED) if you have it (otherwise, also complete Part 2).
3. When this form and your non-US high school diploma have been uploaded and verified, apply for scholarship via your OEC Registry account.
