INDIVIDUAL ATTENTION

PERSONALLY BY THE INTERESTED

The process is personal and doesn't require agents.

You can start the process of the criminal records certificate at the nearest place to your residence.

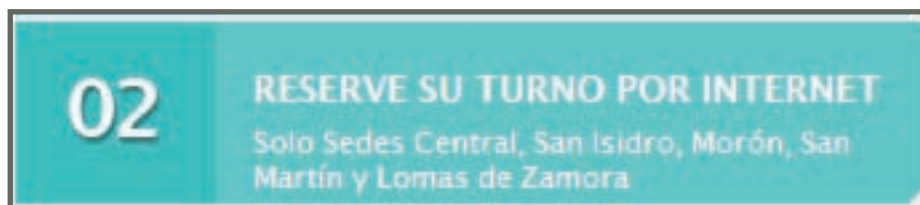

HOW TO START THE PROCESS

Without appointment: you can go to any headquarter with the required documents, excepting the Central Headquarter, Migrations, Lomas de Zamora, San Martin, Morón and San Isidro.

With appointment: you can reserve your appointment to go to the Central Headquarter, Migrations, San Isidro, Morón, San Martín and Lomas de Zamora in www.dnrec.jus.gov.ar by clicking on the option:



You can also call to 0800-666-0055, from 7am to 6pm.

REQUIREMENTS

You have to bring a valid identity document and a clear copy. What is more, to avoid delay, you can complete before the criminal records certificate application form. It has to be sign by the interested.



Go to the application form

You can pay the ticket that appears in the application form at any branch office of the Nation Bank or at any headquarter with their own cashiers (Central Headquarter, Migrations, Autódromo, San Isidro, San Martín, Lomas de Zamora, Morón and La Plata).

The user has to keep the tickets and attach them to the application form.

IMPORTANT: every application form includes an ID number for the Register. So it's necessary not to print it more than once. More than one application form with the same ID number won't be accepted.

PRICES

- Certificate in 6hs: \$250. Only in Central Headquarter, La Plata, San Isidro, San Martín, Morón, Lomas de Zamora and Migrations.
- Certificate in 24hs: \$150
- Certificate in 5 business days: \$60
- Teachers: with the GCBA application form \$35.

ACCESS TO THE CRIMINAL RECORDS CERTIFICATE

When the process starts, the operator will give the user a voucher as a proof of the initial step which depends on where the user began the process.

This voucher has a security code to download the certificate from www.dnrec.jus.gov.ar.

According to the price you paid, the certificate will be available at the web, clicking on the item "If you begin the process at a Register headquarter" or the item "If you begin the process at a UER headquarter", depending on the case. Then, you have to introduce the required codes, including "captcha" code following the appropriate numbers and letters.

IMPORTANT: people between 16 and 18 years old have to go with one of their parents, or tutor, and bring their birth certificate.

PROCESS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES (EXCEPT SPAIN)

STEPS TO DO THE CRIMINAL RECORDS CERTIFICATE:

FIRST STEP:

Click on the next button to complete the criminal records certificate application form, which contains the paying tickets, and choose the type of process "By agent...", depending on the case:



Go to the application form

After you complete the application form and click the "Send" button, it'll generate a PDF document, with two pages that you'll have to print. The first page is the application form with the paying tickets, which must be signed by the interested. The second page is the criminal records Certificate voucher, which must be kept by the user in order to access the criminal records certificate digitally.

REQUIRED CODES TO CONSULT THE CERTIFICATE

Application form Code and Security Code.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

In case of losing your Certificate voucher, you have to go with your Identity Document to the place where you began the process.

IMPORTANT: every application form includes an ID number for the Register. So its necessary not to print it more than once. More than one application form with the same ID number won't be accepted.

SECOND STEP:

Report at the nearest Argentine Consulate from your residence (www.cancilleria.gov.ar) with:

- A valid identity Document and a clear copy.
- Criminal Records Certificate application form completed and signed by the interested.
- Agent authorization (art. 6, decree N° 2004/80, law 22.117).

With order consent by authorization:

Authorization, with the finger print of the interested. It will be reported in Argentina with the original Identity Document and a copy. You can download the authorization by clicking here:

The attorney will have to present in Argentina the following documentation:

With consent by notary public: original power document and a copy. Original Identity Document and a copy of the attorney.

With legal representation: Original documentation and a copy, that gives assurance of the user legal representation. Original Identity Document and a copy of the attorney.

Important: the personal of the Argentine Consulate will take the finger prints of both hands and will certificate the required documentation.

THIRD STEP:

Deliver the Criminal Records application form and other documentation to the agent.

Important: remember to keep the "Voucher of Criminal Records Certificate- started by agent".

FORTH STEP:

The agent will report all the documentation at any headquarter. Check the available headquarters in the following item:

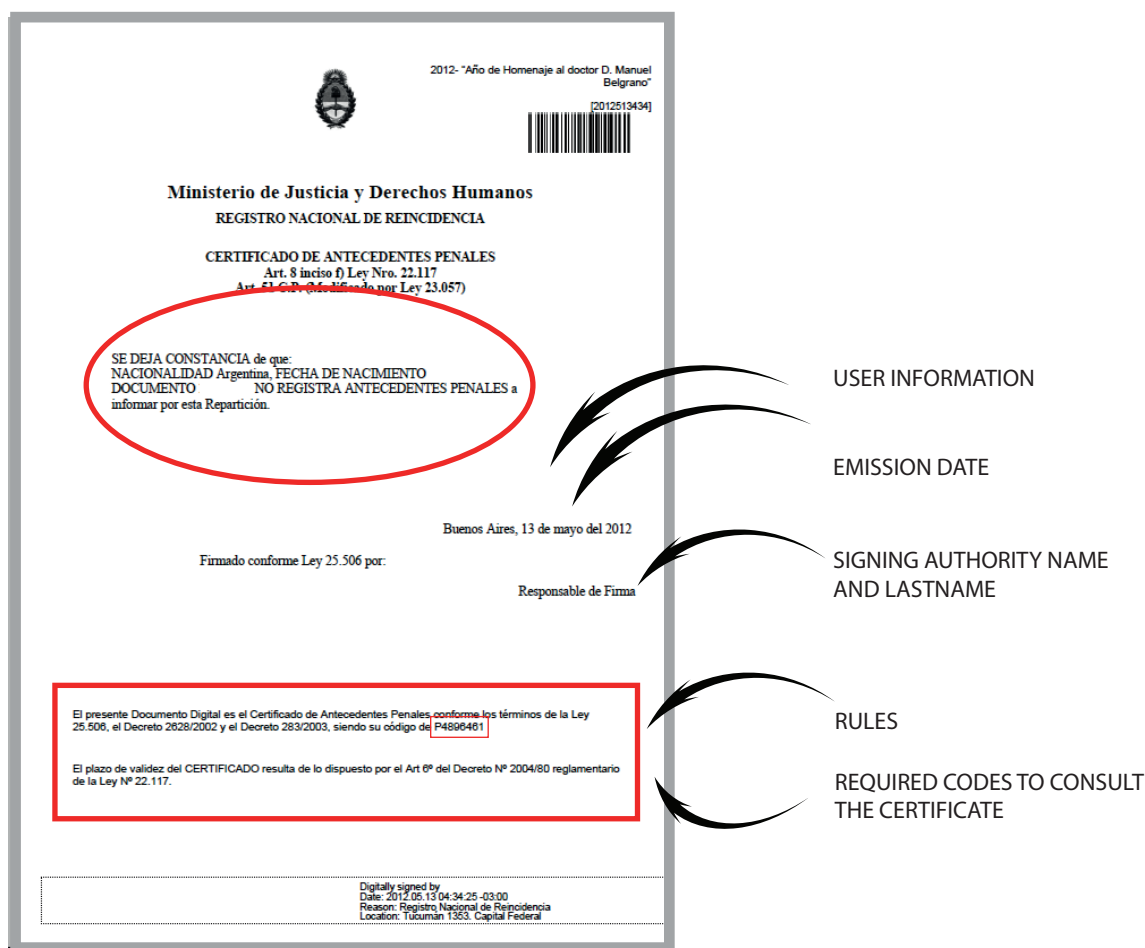
You can pay the ticket that appears in the application form at any branch office of the Nation Bank or at any headquarter with their own cashiers (Central Headquarter, Lomas de Zamora, San Isidro, San Martín, Morón and La Plata). The price depends on the term you choose:

- Certificate in 6hs: \$250.
- Certificate in 24hs: \$150
- Certificate in 5 business days: \$60.

FIFTH STEP:

The Criminal Records Certificate will be available when the term is full filed, with the entry date at the National Register.

To access to the certificate you have to get into www.dnrec.jus.gov.ar and click on "access to your Criminal Records certificate". Then, you have to click on the button "if you start the process by mail" and introduce the application form and Security codes that appear in the voucher. What is more, you have to enter the "captcha" code following the appropriate numbers and letters. Finally, you must press "Consult" and in this way you can access at your Criminals Records Certificate.
