Completed and signed visa application form duly filled in English.		
One recent passport photo according to ICAO standard, white background; must be recent (not older than 6 months)		
Original passport and copy of Valid Travel Document. Passport should have at least two (2) blank pages face-to-face available for acceptance of visa application. (Applicant's Previous Passport/s in the last 2 years should be provided mandatorily with the new passport.) Passport Should be Valid for 8 months From Date of Application.		
Letter from the applicant's current employer stating how long he has been in employment and what work s/he does with the company in Morocco. Letter has to be stamped and signed by the Employer on Company letterhead. Name of signatory has to be clearly visible. (This letter has to be submitted mandatorily).		
Confirmed Accommodation Reservation		
Confirmed air ticket/s. If ticket is presented, a copy is retained.		
Health Insurance acceptable in the Schengen Area (minimum coverage has to be 30,000 Euros) and should cover the period of validity of visa.

Proof of Employment in Malta: Letter from employer indicating name, address, telephone number of the employer, position of applicant, tenure duration, salary.		
Employment License as issued by the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC) in Malta. Work Permit Letter (Approval in Principle - AIP) should be valid and have the current Passport details at the time of submission. Expired Approval in Principle Letters beyond 180 days will definitely not be accepted.		
Signed Employment Contract certified True Copy by a Maltese Lawyer or Notary Public.		
Proof of Accommodation in Malta/ Declaration of Proof form, duly notarized along with copy of the ID card of the host.		
Applicants with an Employment License to work as drivers (of any type) must provide a copy of their driving license in Morocco or International Driving License.		
Applicant with an Employment License to work in skilled jobs eg: electrician, plumber, engineer, chef de partie, IT professional, medical/caring professions, or any other skills/professions that require a training certificate, diploma or degree, needs to submit qualifications showing that s/he is qualified to carry out that job.

Original Letter of Acceptance by the Maltese Education Institution including details of the course, duration and fees with proof of payment.		
Proof of sufficient and regular personal financial means (Original bank statement for the past 6 months). If the sponsor will cover the expenses, original bank statement for 6 months should be presented along with the guarantee letter and passport copy.		
Proof of Employment: Those in full time gainful employment should submit a letter from the employer indicating name, address, telephone number of your employer, position of applicant, tenure duration, salary and confirmation that the applicant will resume duties on his return.		

Those in full-time education should submit a letter from their education establishment clearly indicating the course of studies being followed.		
Proof of Accommodation in Malta/ Declaration of Proof form, duly notarized.		
Letter from the Institute undertaking the return of student to the country of residence upon completion of the study.

- The applicant has submitted the supporting documents above. I have advised him/her that failure to submit all necessary documents may result in the application being refused and visa fee is non-refundable. He/she has chosen to proceed with the application.
