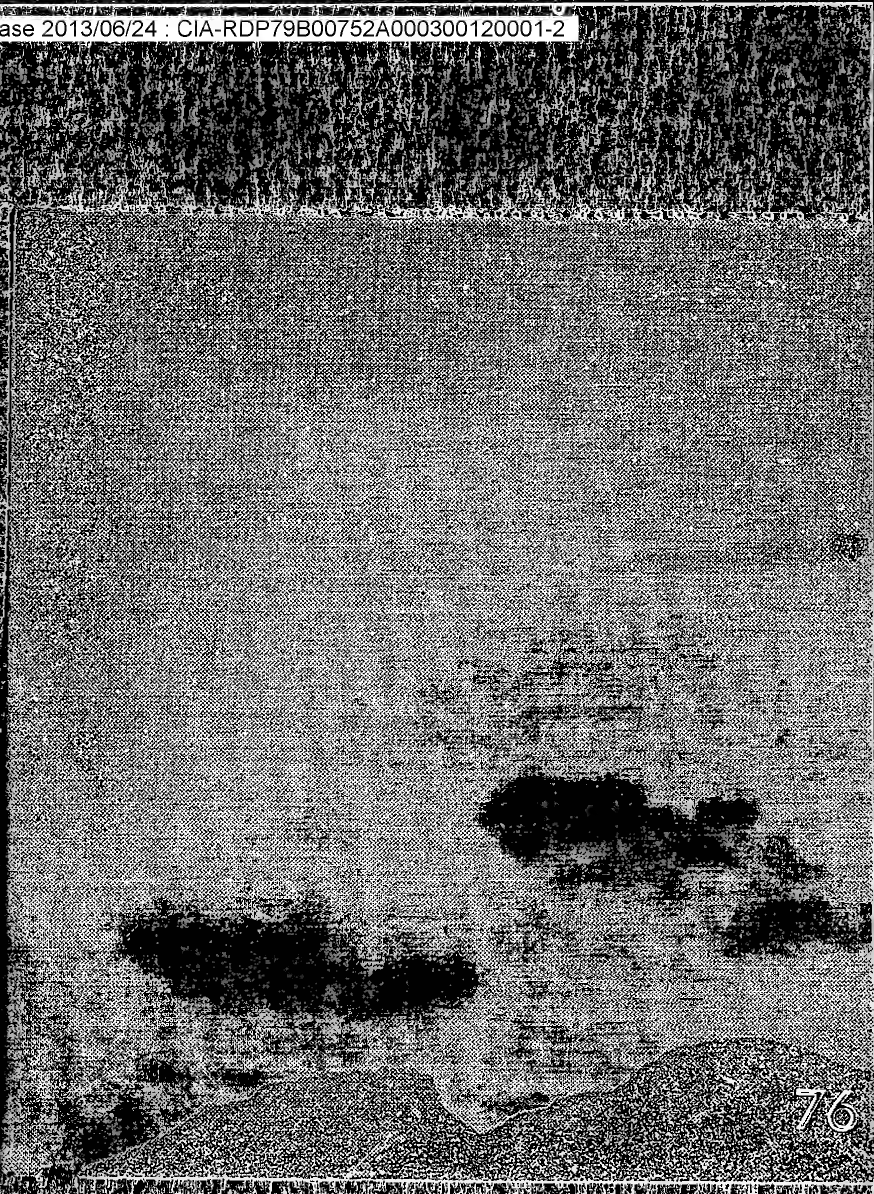

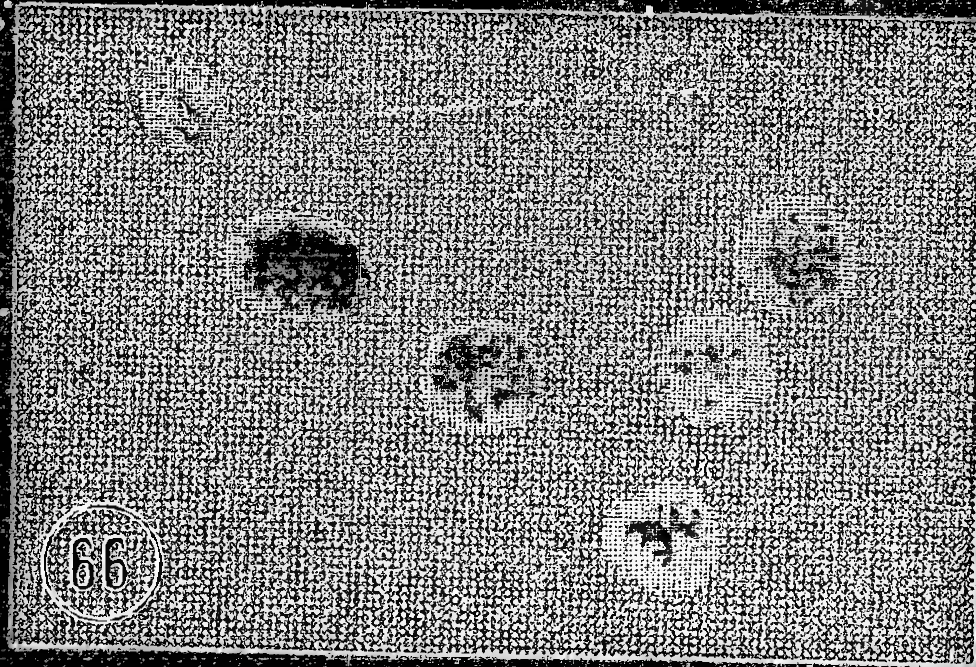

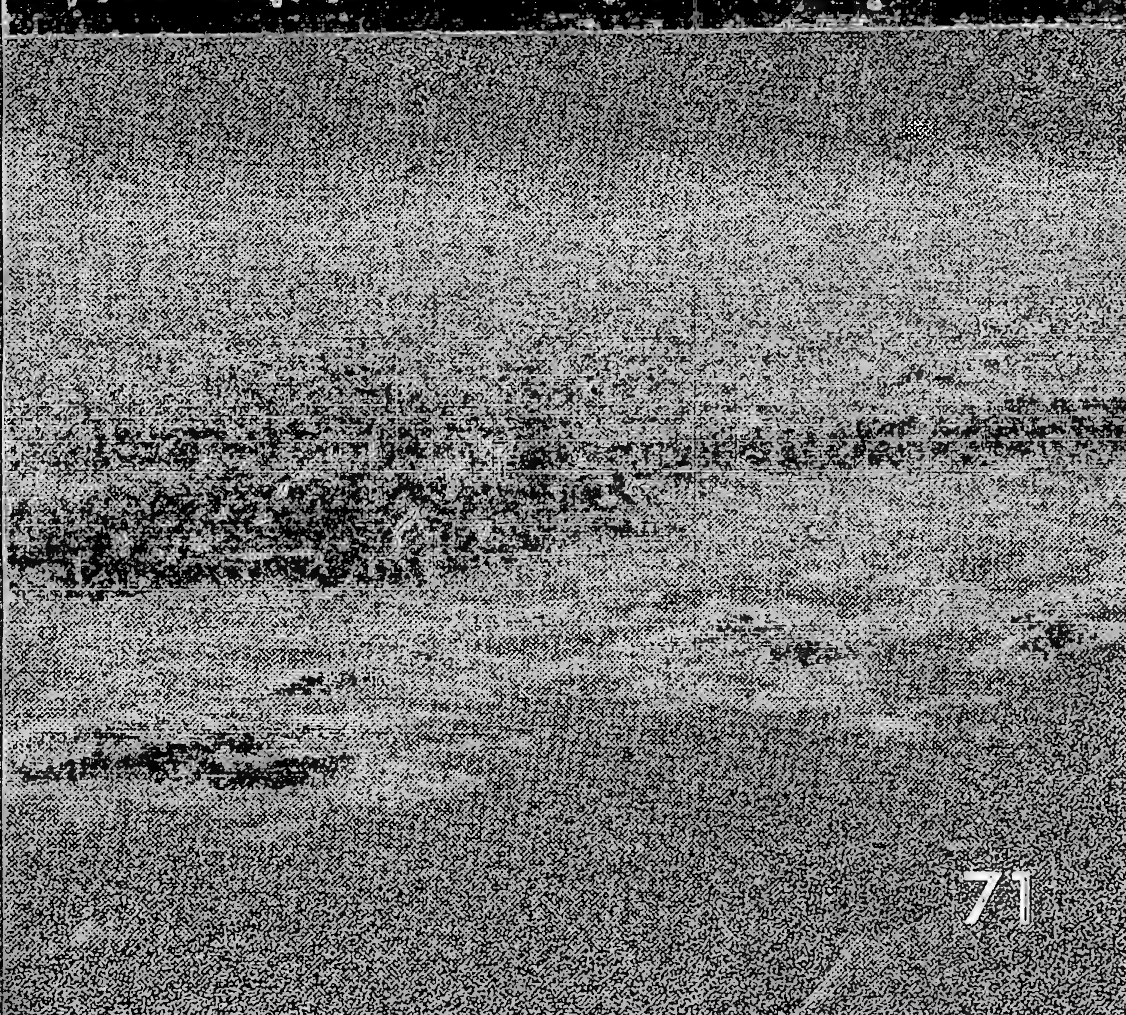

These six UFO's were seen and drawn by Astronomer Barnard, October 14, 1882, and were only 6° from the head of the great comet of 1882. They were accompanied by a spindle-shaped object, looking like a "mother ship" only a few degrees away. This comet had a tail which preceded it, and a complicated head which contained moving parts. Schmidt, at Athens, saw a number of these nebulous UFO's move away from the comet into space.

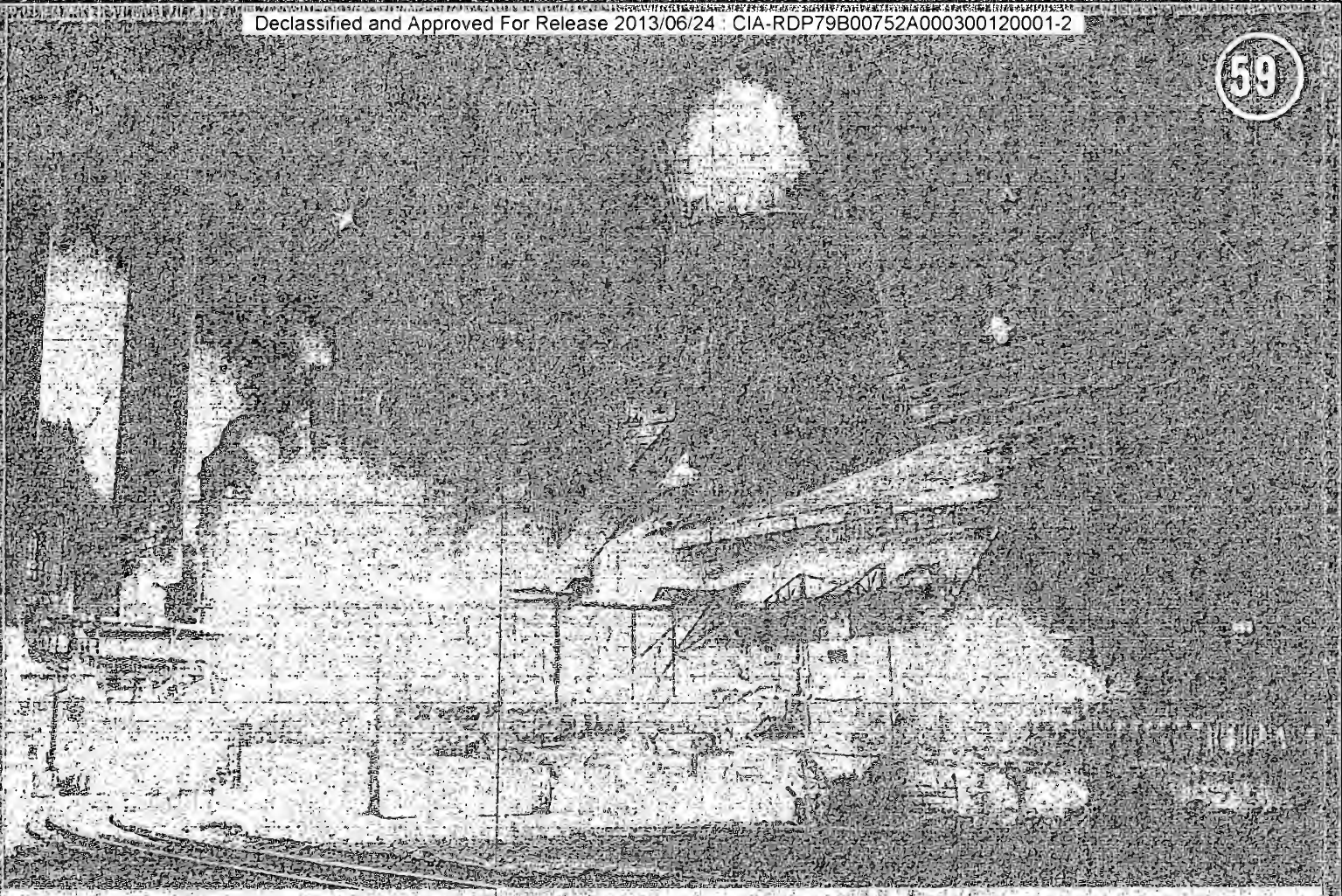

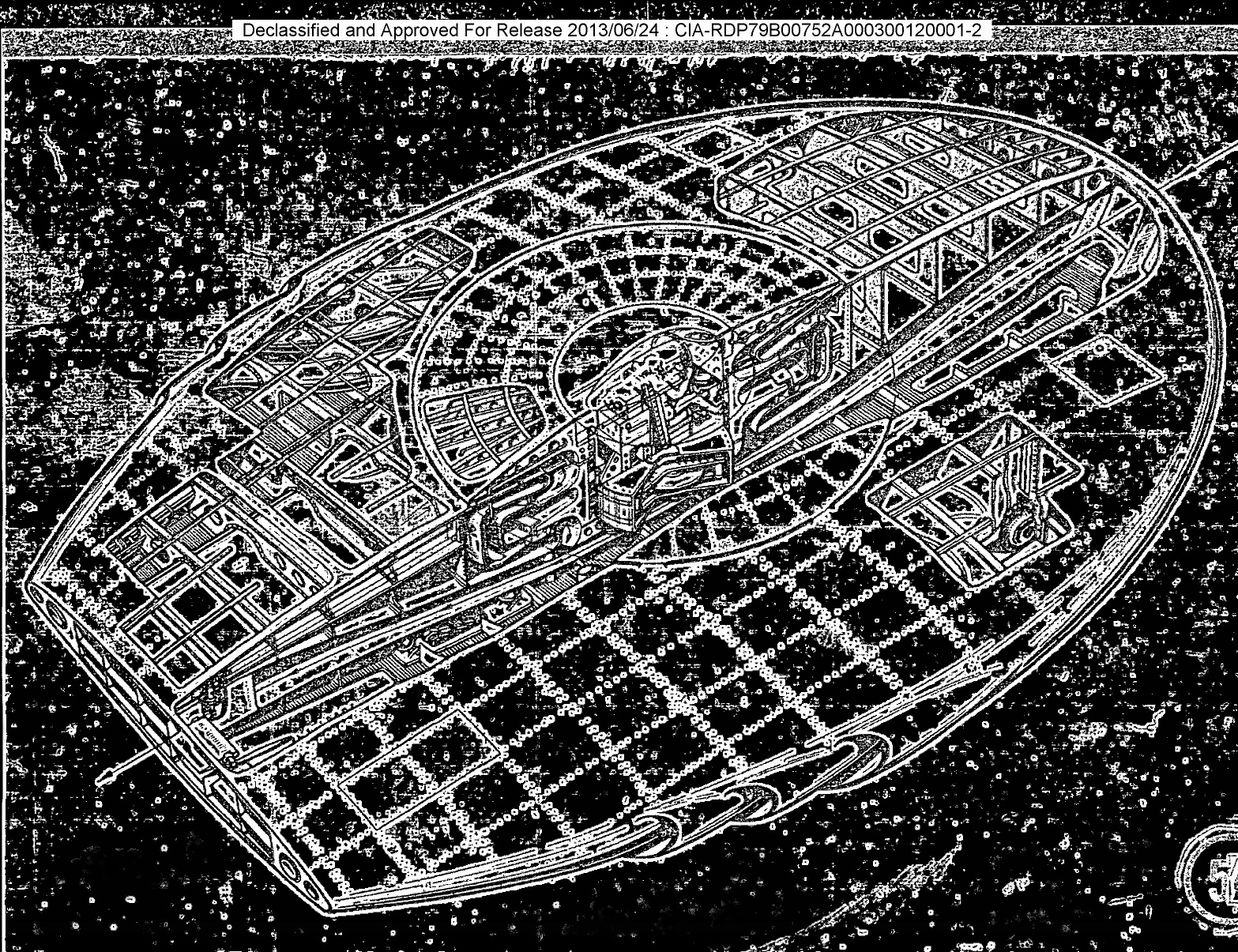

Author's impression of a sectional view of a Scott Ship

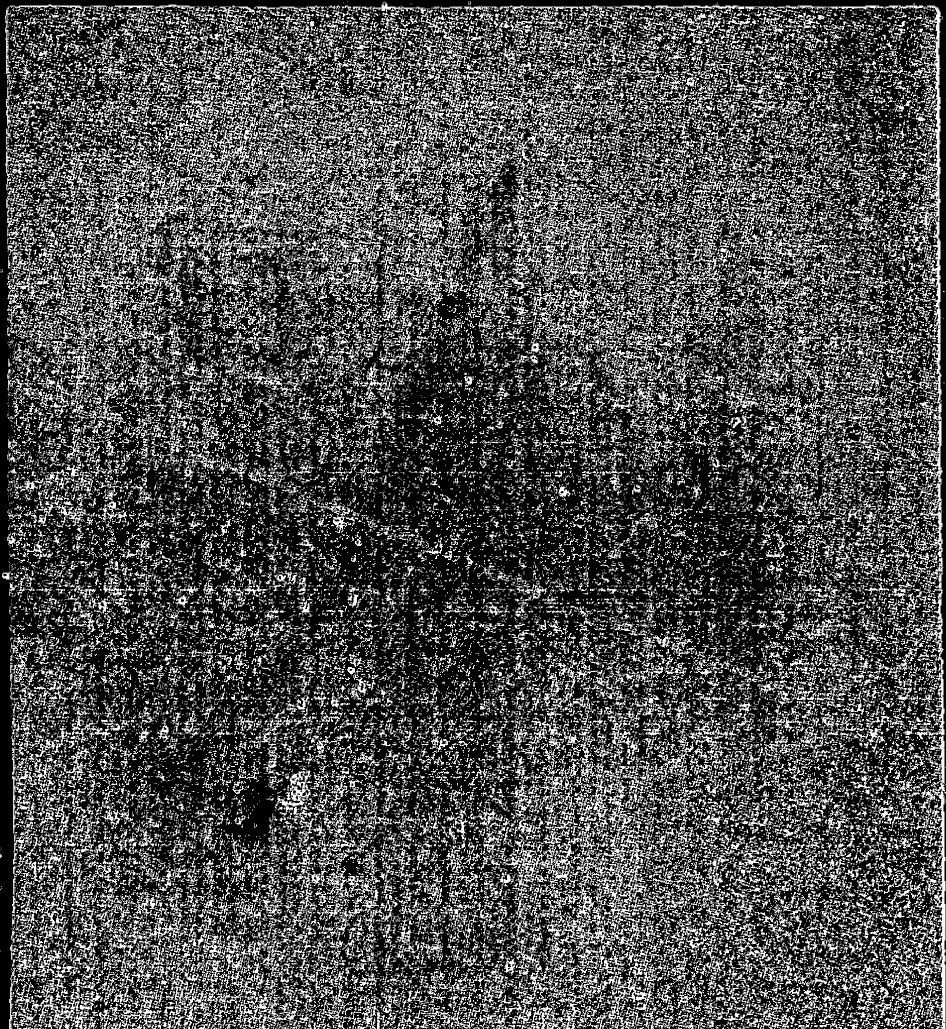

A week later, on 4th March, 1951, *The Sunday Dispatch* referred again to this sighting and reproduced a sketch of the mysterious object, as under:



The newspaper made the following comments:

Flying in a cloudless sky over Mount Kilimanjaro, Tanganyika, Captain Jack Bicknell, pilot of a passenger plane bound for Mombasa, saw through binoculars "a metallic, bullet-shaped object which must have been more than 200 feet long". *The Sunday Dispatch* last week gave a detailed report of this Flying Saucer sighting, the most authentic so far recorded.

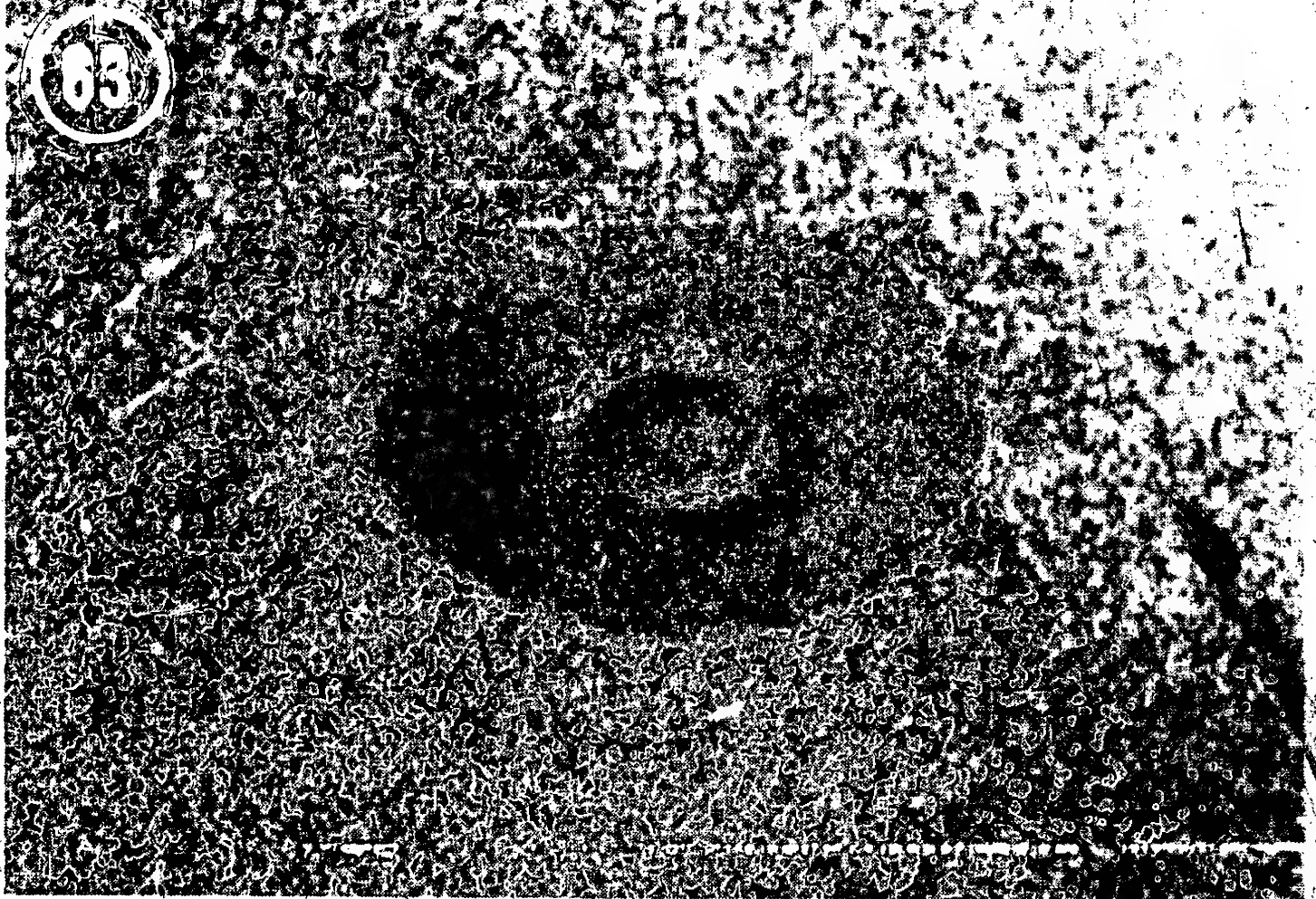
When he brought the plane down, Captain Bicknell drew a sketch of what he had seen.

The diagram above was prepared from Captain Bicknell's sketch and shows the "large object attached to the rear".



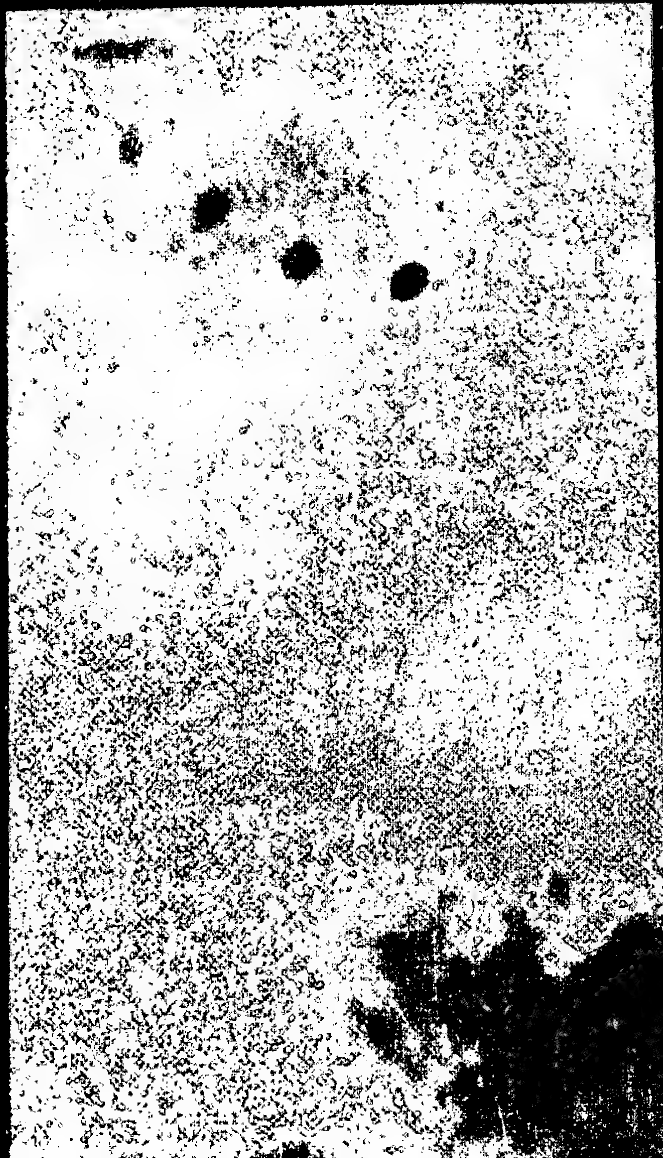

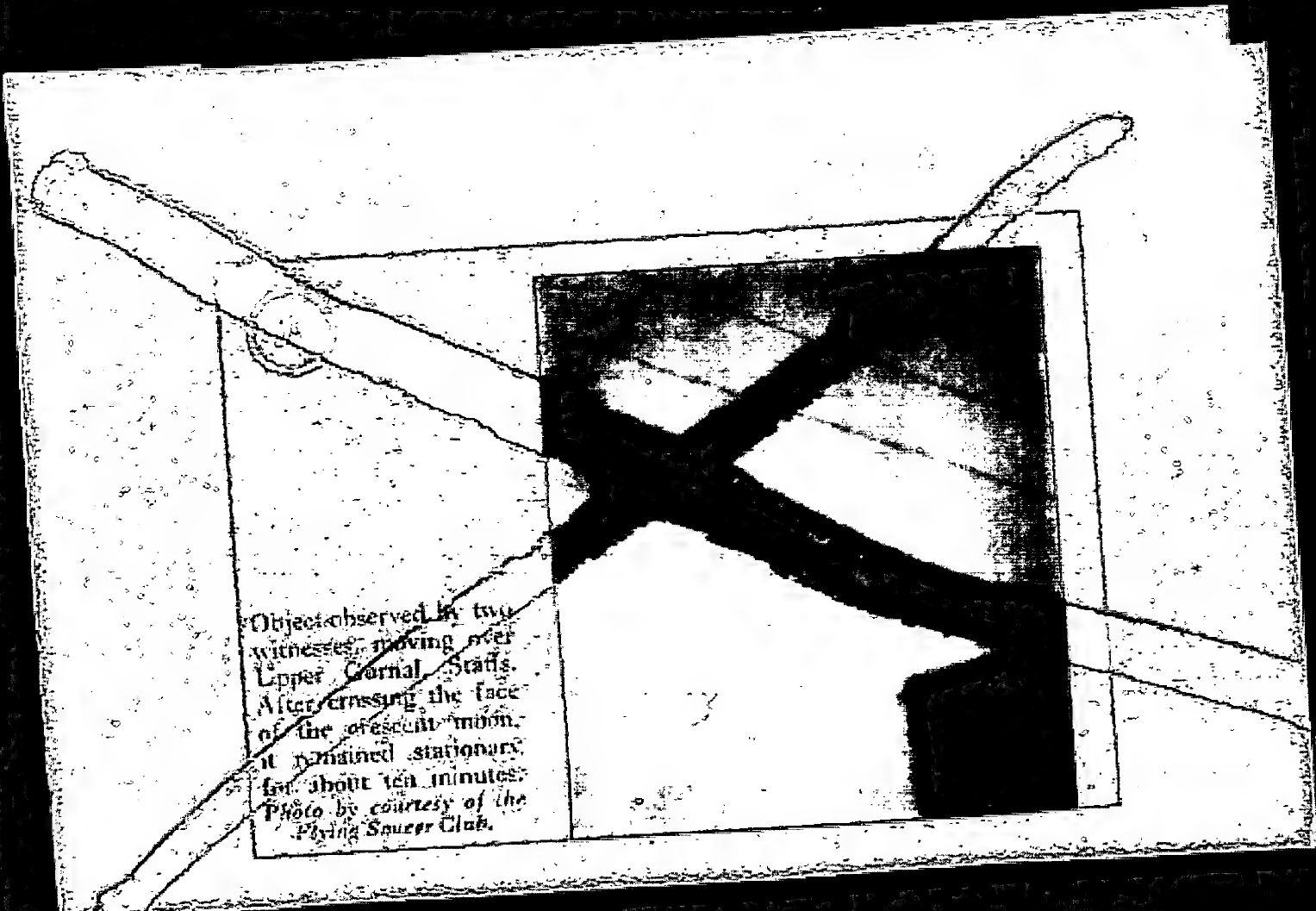

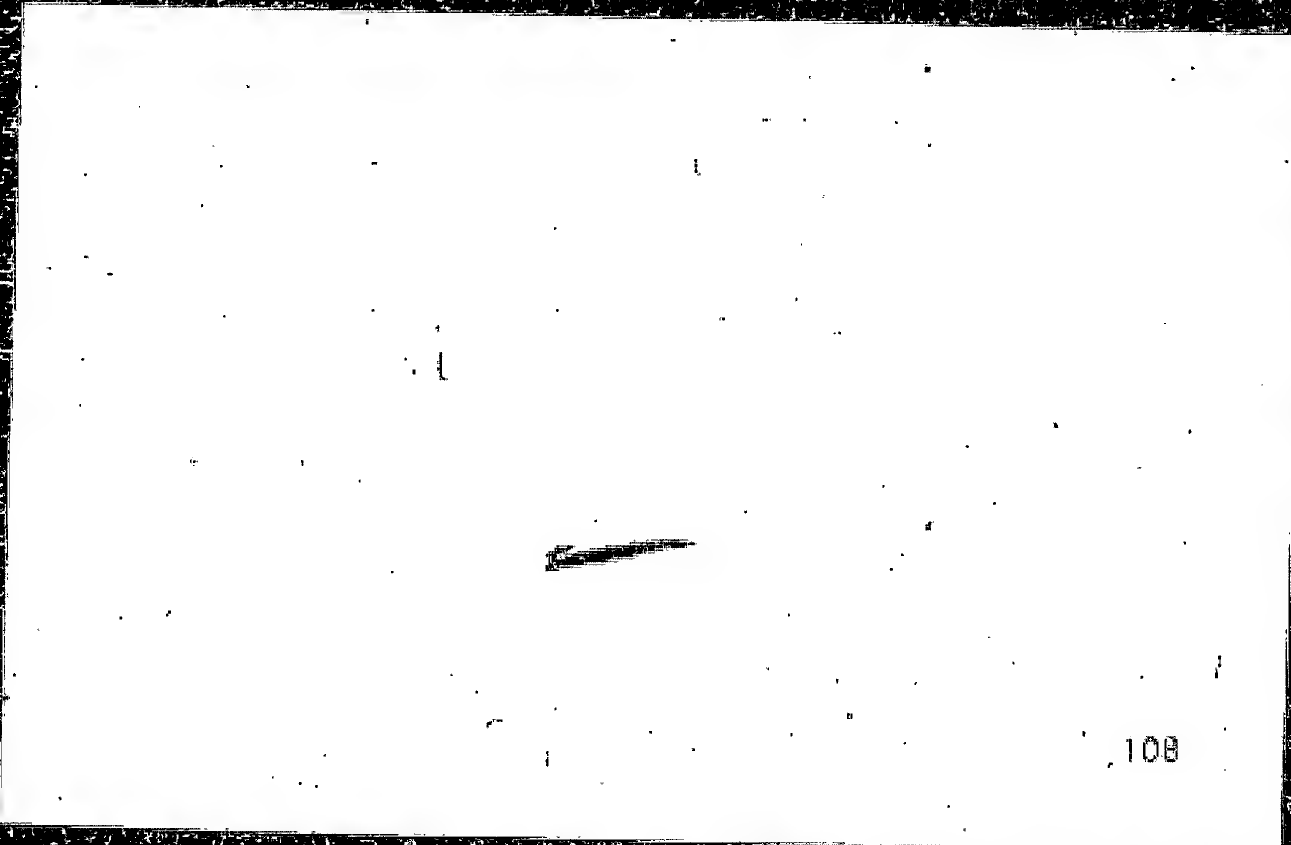

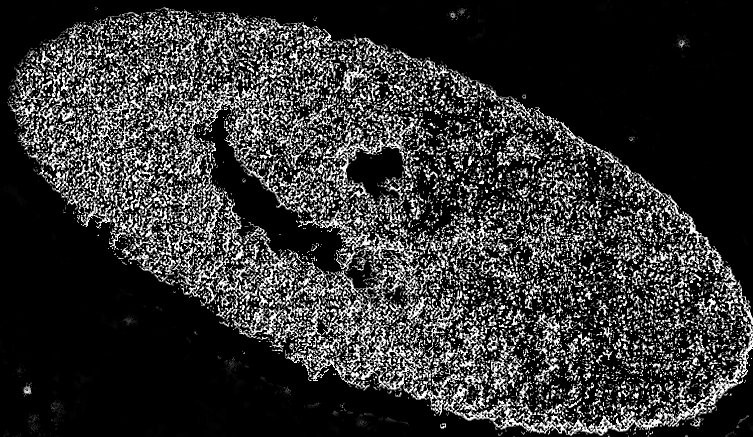

Plate 2 Brazilian Flying Saucer

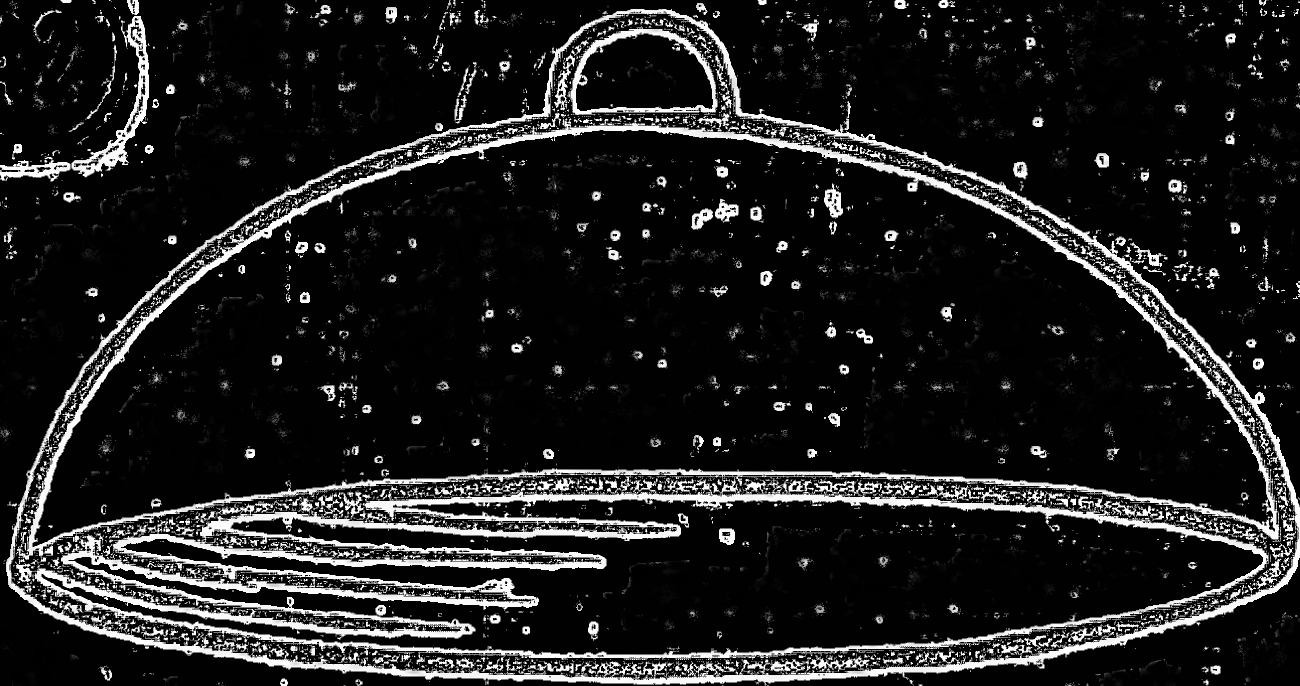
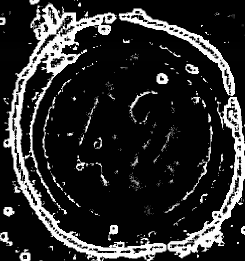

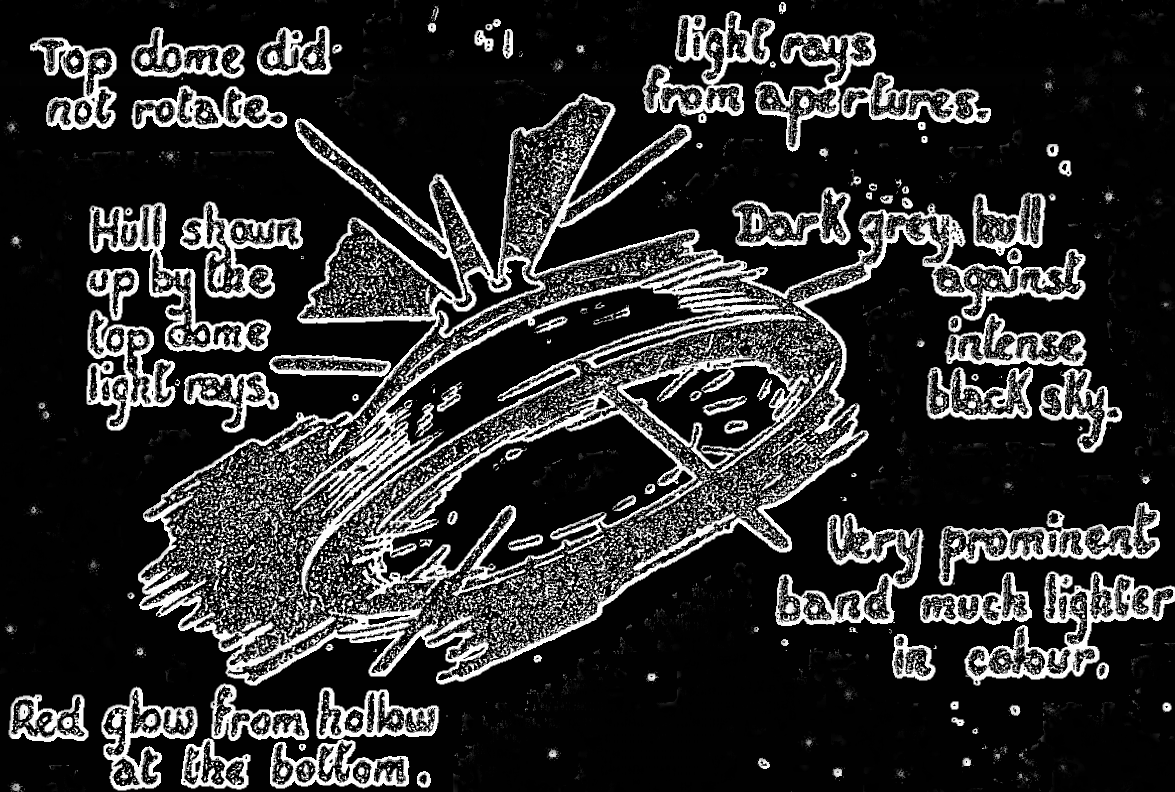
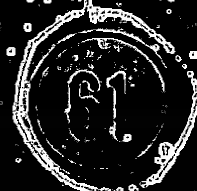


Fig. 1 This drawing, reproduced by courtesy of the "Evening News," was copied by a member of that paper's staff from a sketch made by Mr. F. W. Potter immediately after he had sighted the object he describes.

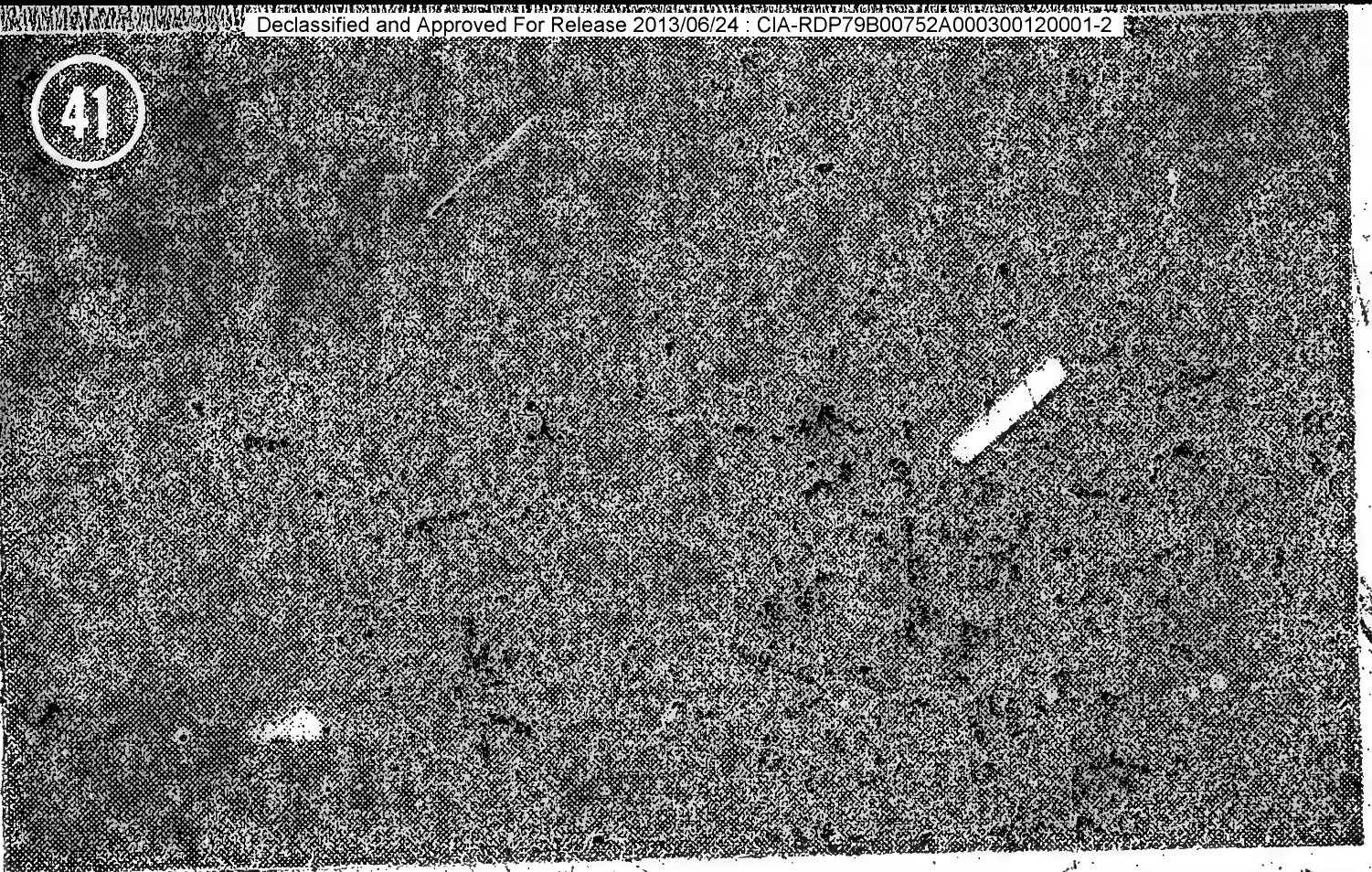

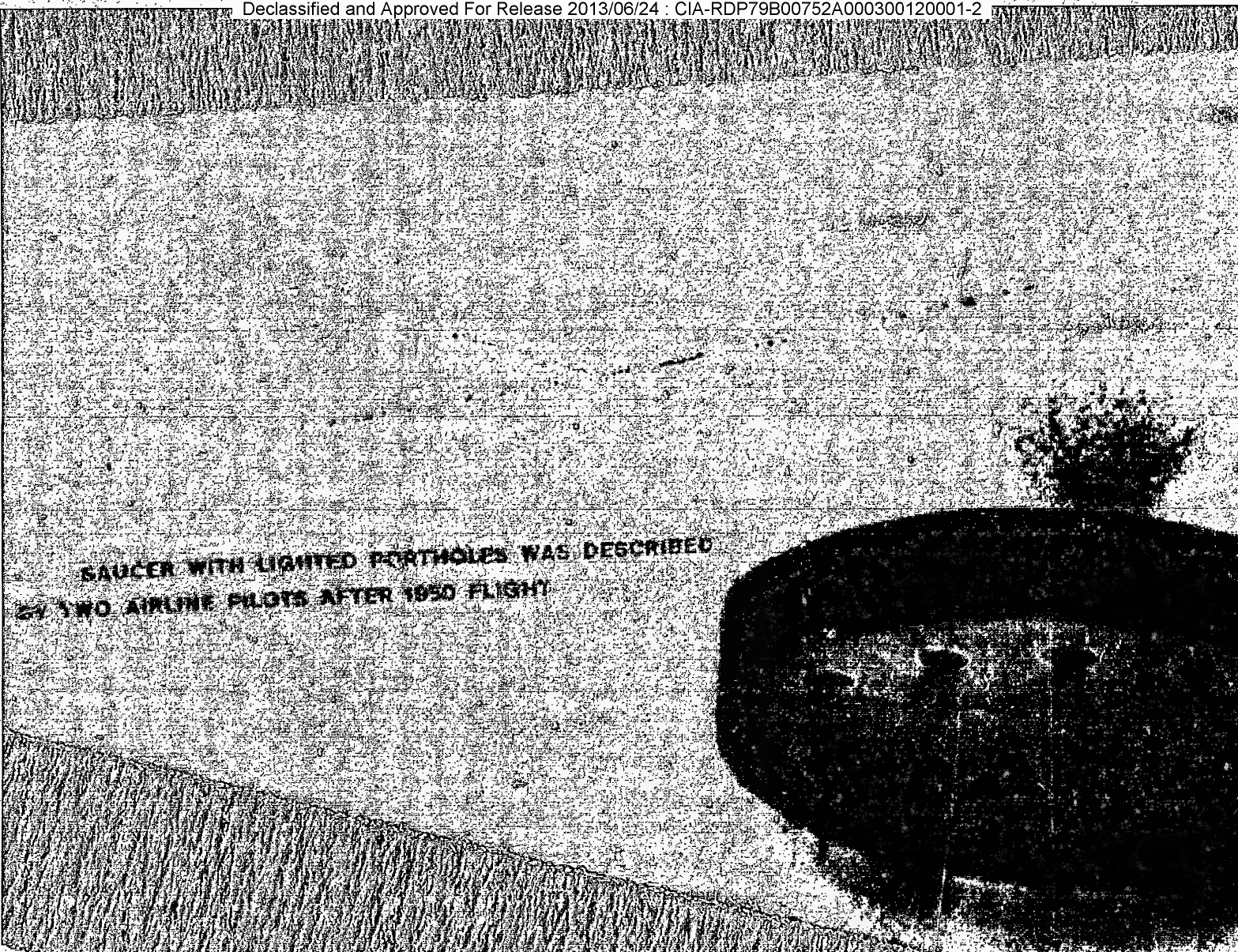

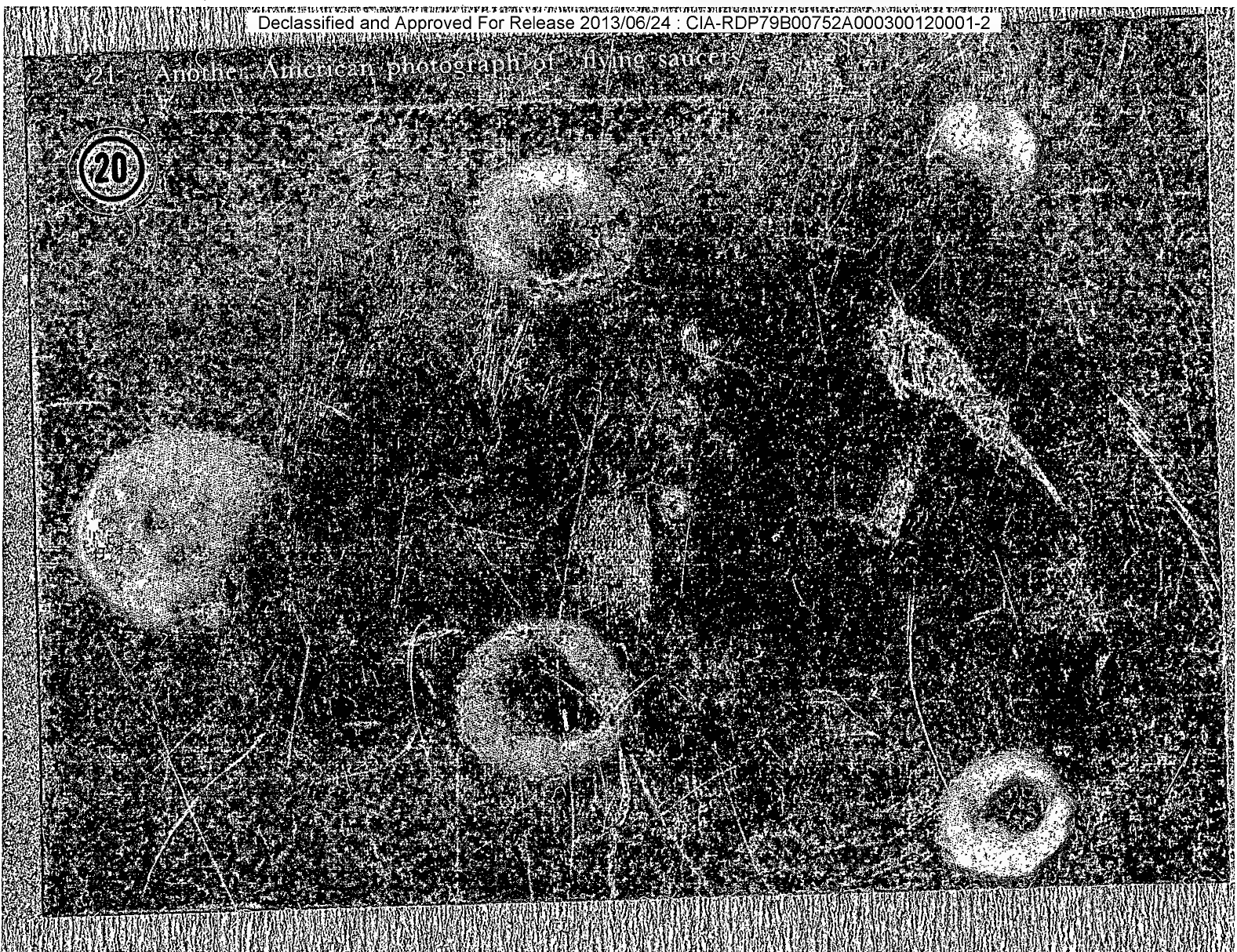



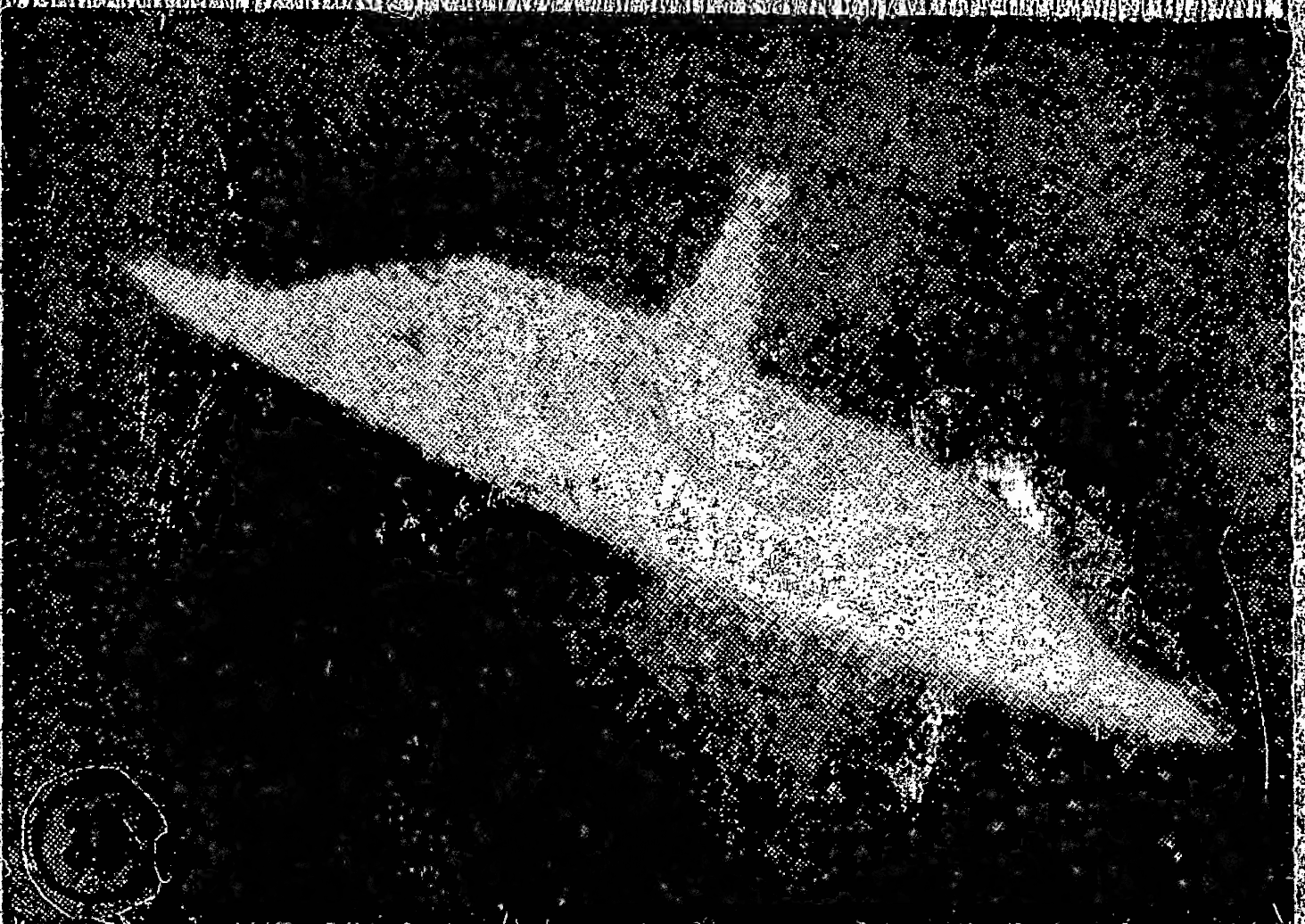

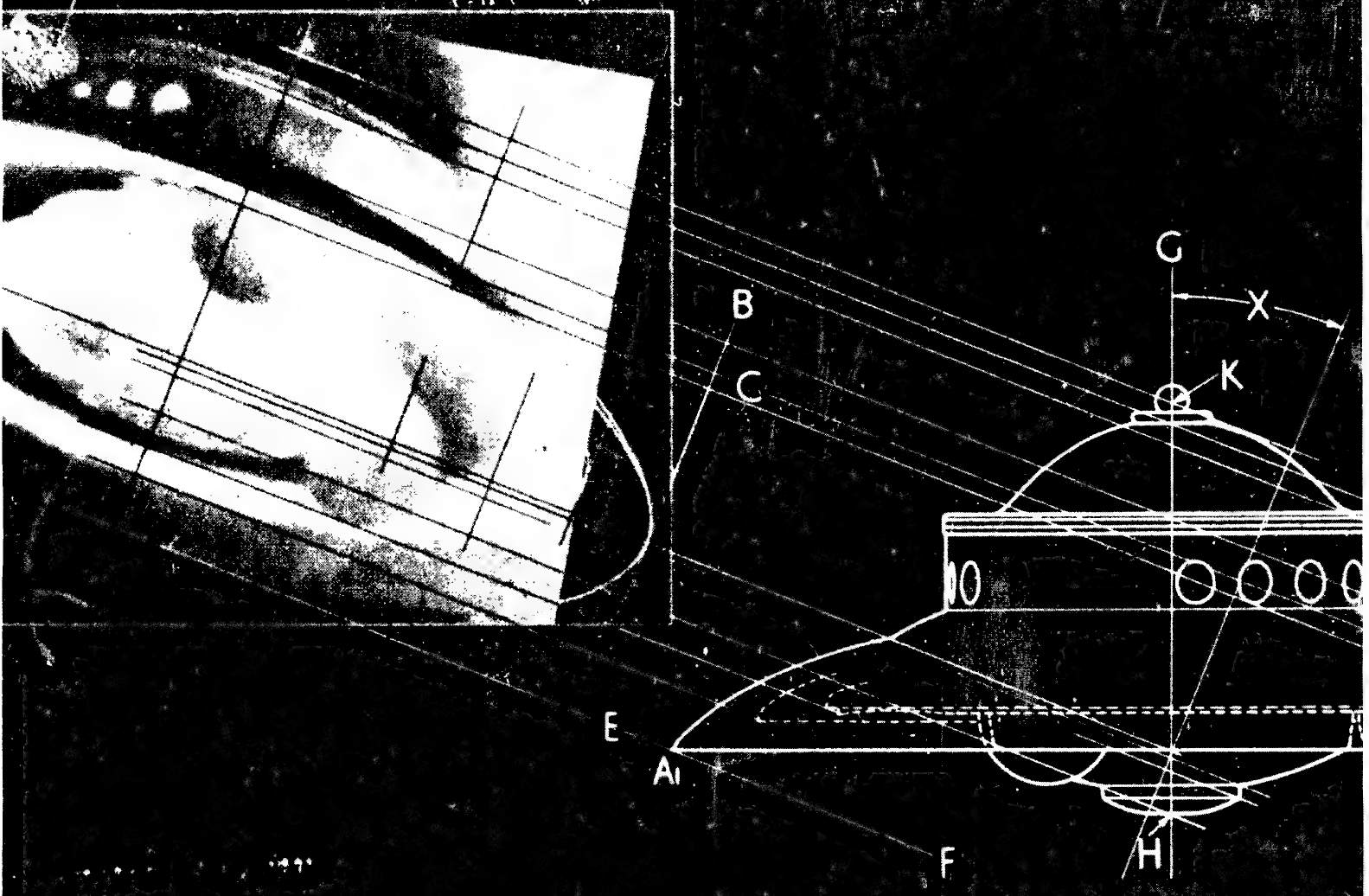

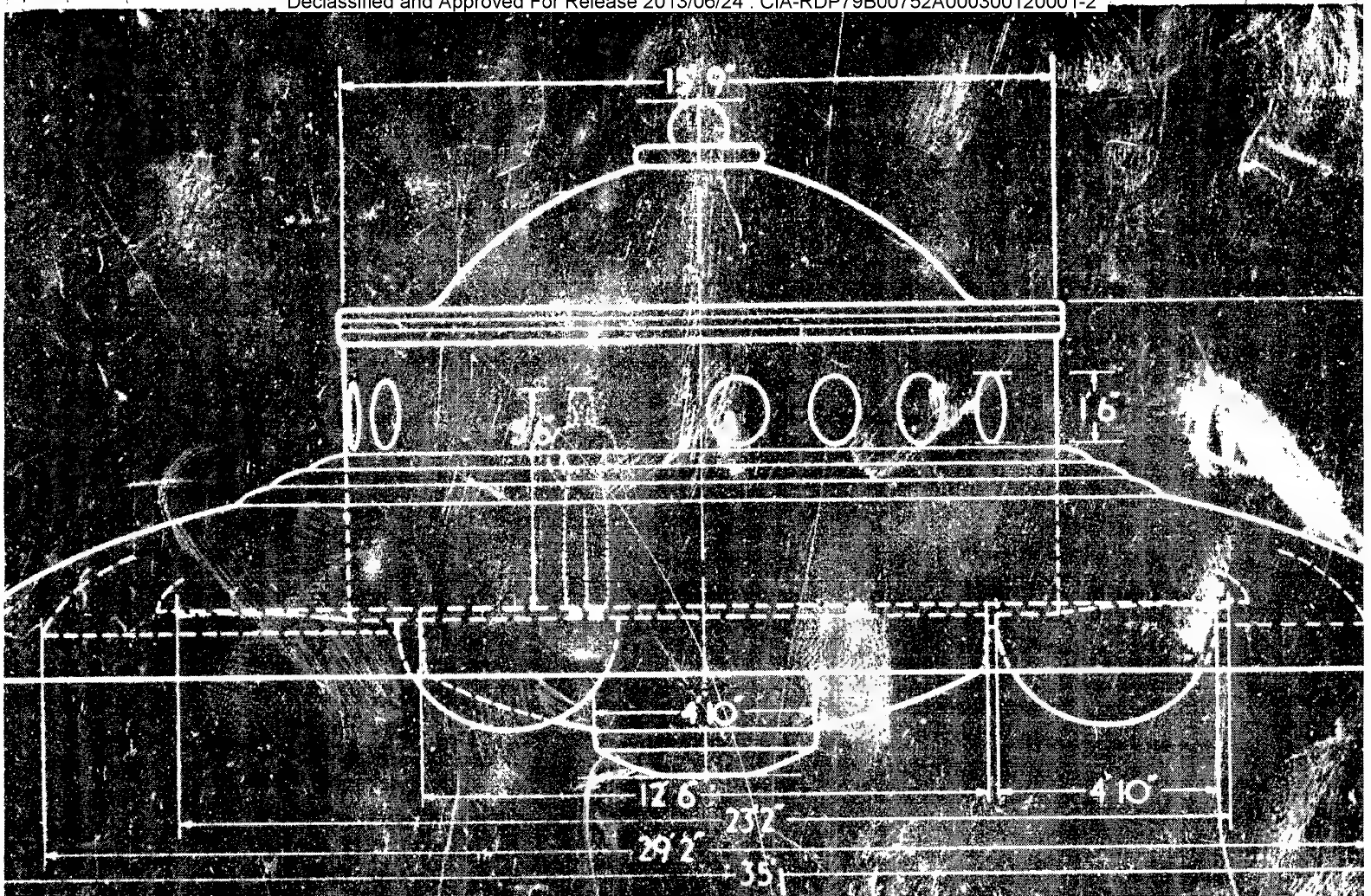

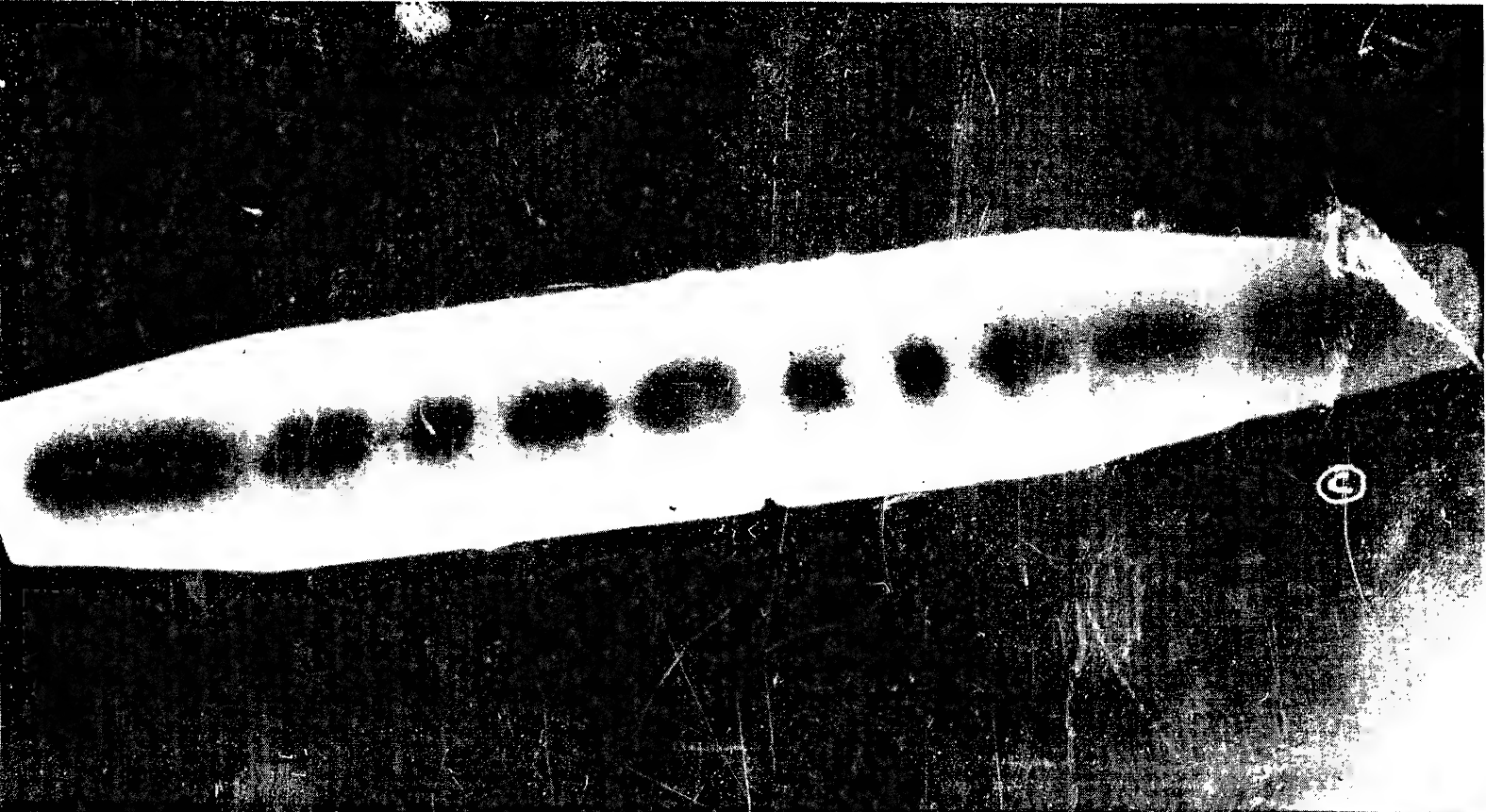

A similar giant carrier ship appeared again at 7:58 a.m. 1 May 1952. It was of a shining silvery appearance and almost identical to the one that brought the visiting 'Scout Ship' six months later on 20 November. This

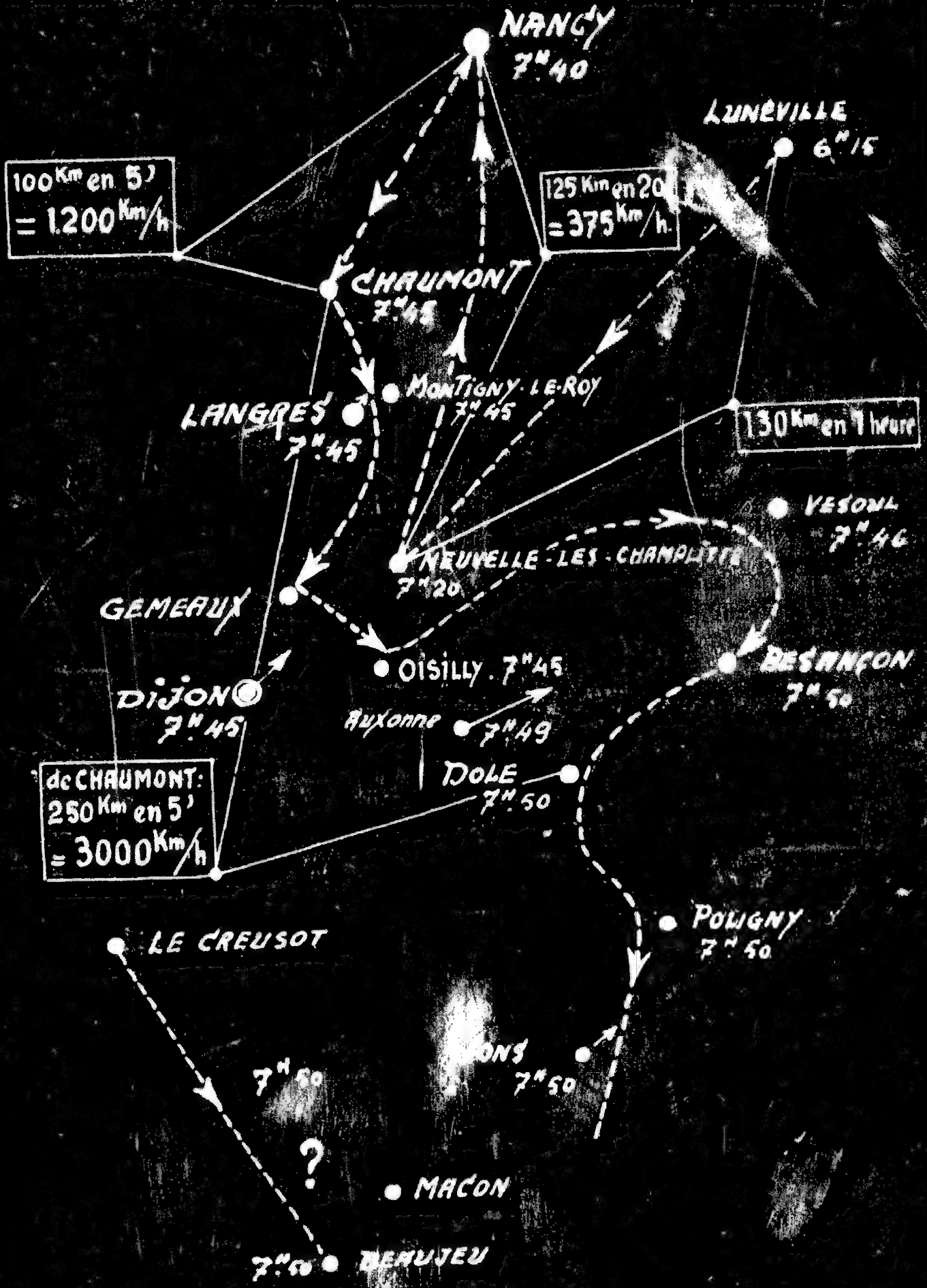


Chart drawn by investigator Charles Garreau reproducing the eccentric flight path of the plane seen on January 9, 1954, as reported by hundreds of witnesses

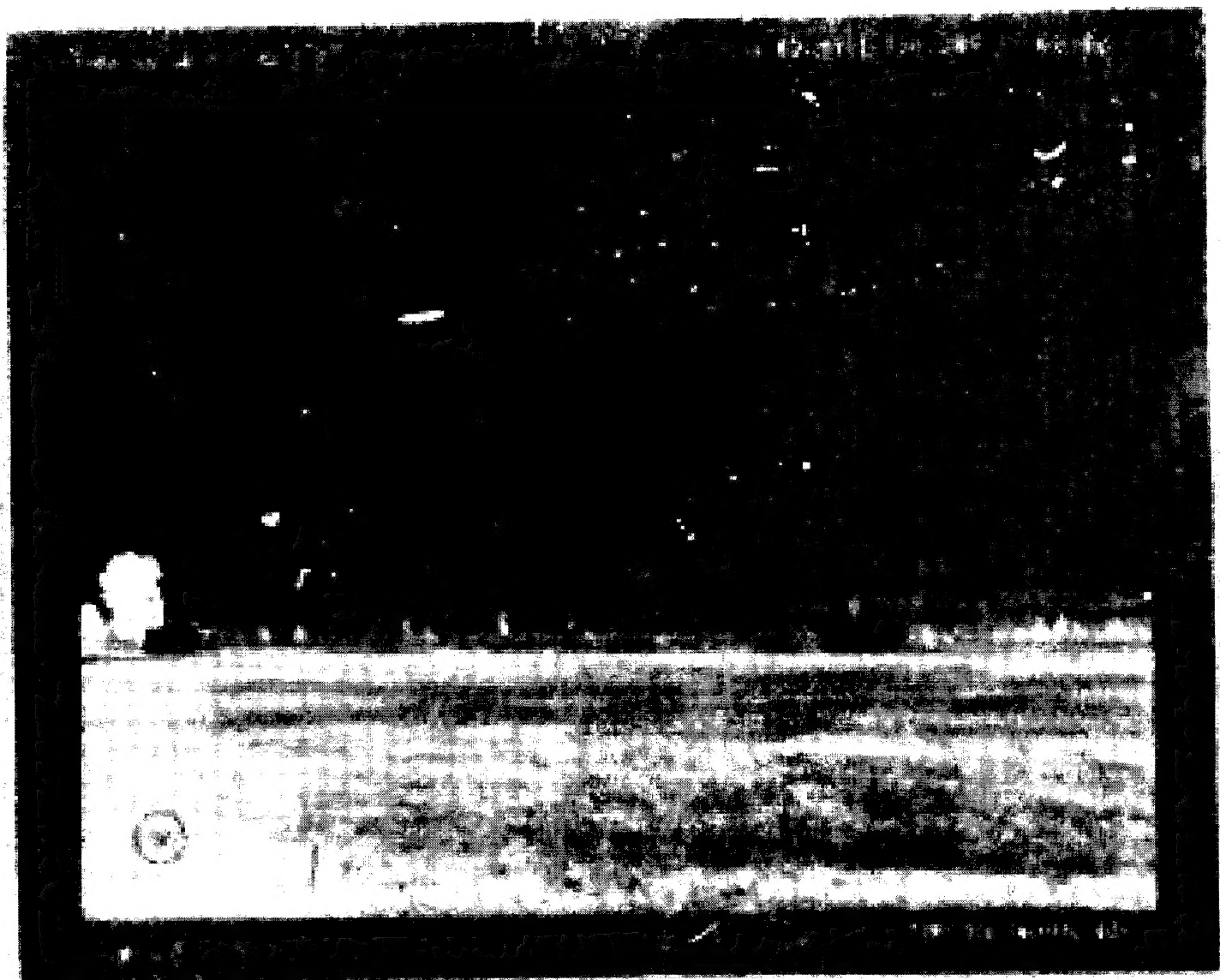


White "hot spot" in lower spine, in thermogram, right, indicates a slipped disc.

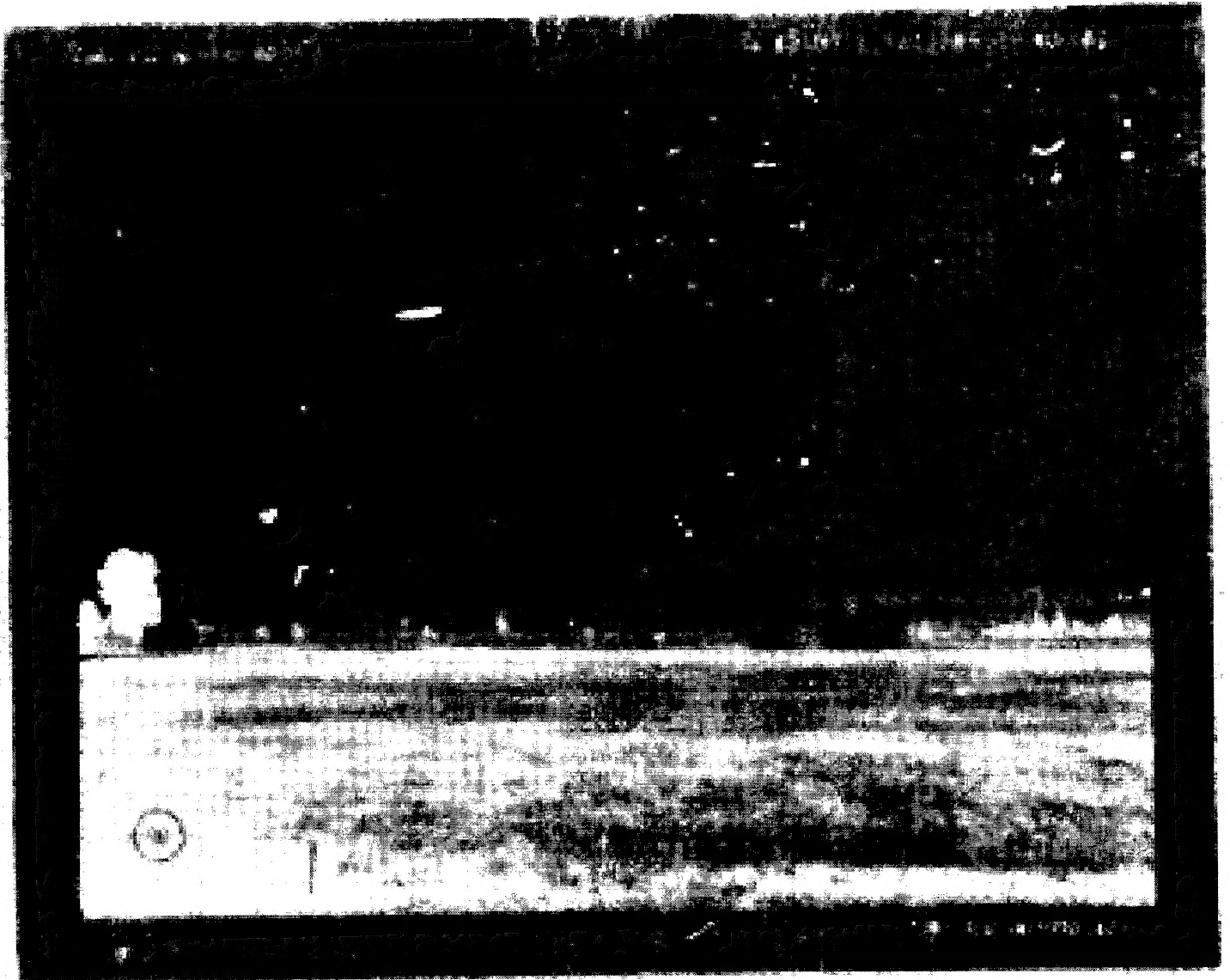
