Objectives:

This course is designed to develop the four language skills, speaking, listening, reading and writing in Korean. It covers the basic grammatical structures and vocabulary necessary for basic conversation, reading comprehension, and writing sentences to help the students build a solid foundation for further study in Korean language. The course also provides useful information concerning culture (where culture touches on language and communication) and everyday life in Korea.

- Speaking: Ability to maintain simple face-to face conversation by asking and answering simple questions entirely in Korean
- Listening: Ability to comprehend the learned materials
- Writing: Ability to write simple sentences and expression
- Reading: Ability to comprehension simple texts
