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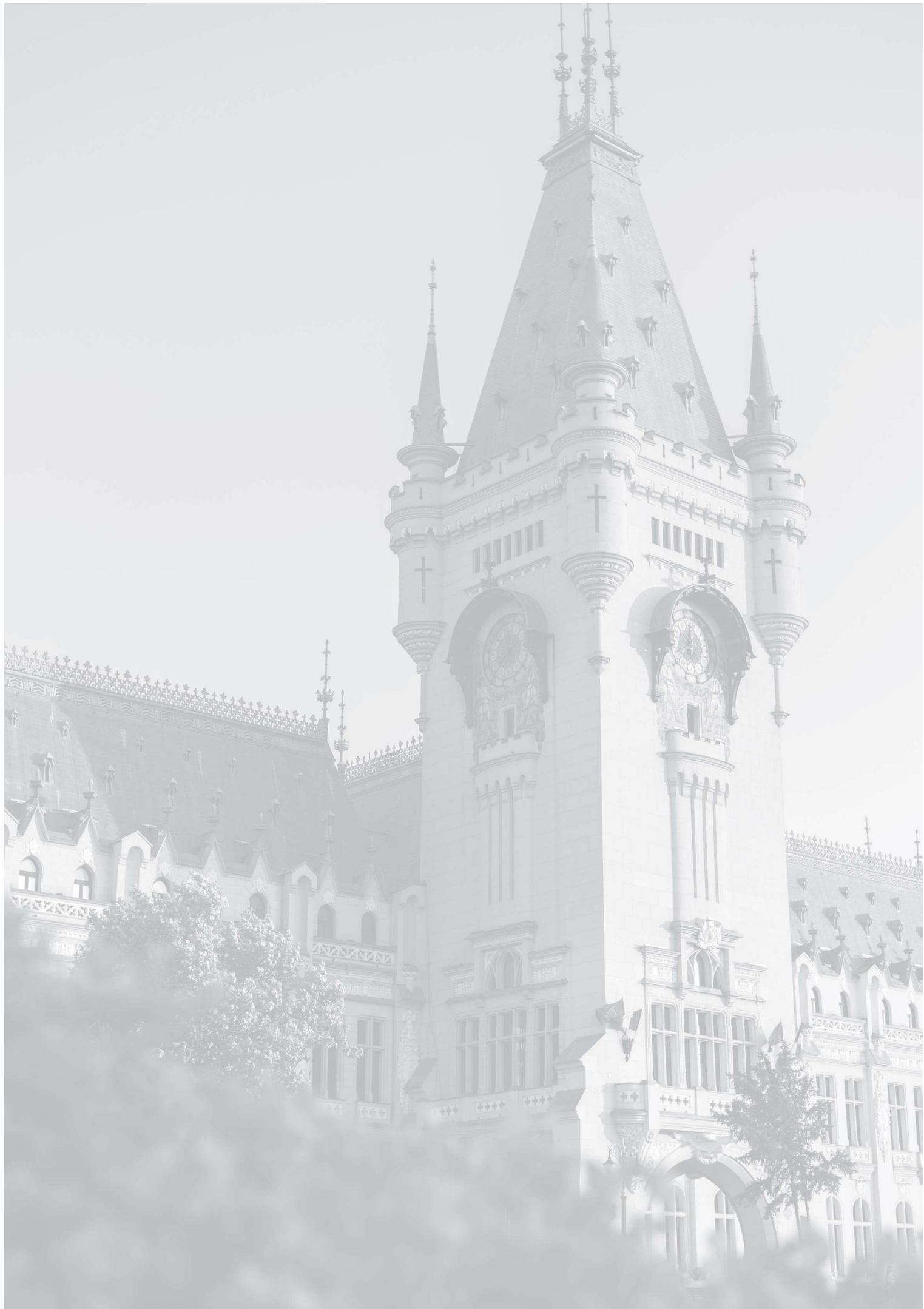

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ÖSYM sınavlarında 'zamir' konusu

ÖSYM sınavlarında zamir konusu ile ilgili dilbilgisi bölümünde boşluk doldurma soruları sık sık sorulmaktadır. Zamirler cümle ve parça tamamlama sorularında ayrıca anlamı bozan ifadeyi soran sorularda belirleyici bir etkiye sahiptir.

1. Introduction

Cümlede ismin yerini tutan, isim olmadığı halde isim gibi kullanılabilen kelimelere **zamir** denir. 'Possessive adjectives', 'demonstrative adjectives' ve 'other' yapısının kimi kullanımları zamir konusu kapsamında bulunmasa da ÖSYM sınavlarında ve benzer testlerde zamir konusunu hedefleyen soruların seçeneklerinde sıklıkla kullanıldıkları için bu bölüme dahil edilmiştir.

Tablo 1.1'de zamir konusunun 2. ve 6. alt başlıkları arasında incelenen zamir ve sıfatlar şahıslara göre gruplanmıştır.

2. Subject Pronouns (Özne Zamirleri)



Tanım

Öznenin yerine kullanılır ve eylemi yapan kişiyi / şeyi anlatırlar.

- Some university students fail to find a job after graduating since they are not qualified enough.
- The movie has recently been released on DVD in America and it is currently being shown as a feature film in the United Kingdom.
- Because doctors are unlikely to know the amount of radiation a person has received, they usually predict outcome based on the person's symptoms. (ÖSYM)



Dikkat

'You' ve 'they' zamirleri genelleme yapmak için de kullanılabilir.

- "Even a fool is counted wise when he holds his peace", they say.
- If you receive a message reporting that the antivirus software on a computer is out-of-date, you must update it as soon as possible.



Dikkat

Ülke, şehir, gemi ve bayrak isimleri yerine 'she' zamiri (VEYA 'her, hers, herself') kullanılabilir.

- Russia is important since she has got massive resources in the Earth; she has been through many various types of government in her history and has always survived.

3. Object Pronouns (Nesne Zamirleri)



Tanım

Nesne durumundaki ismin yerini alır ve bir fiilden sonra getirilirler.

- My friend told me not to purchase a GPS unit because I had already had an iPhone.
- Parrots are able to form strong bonds with humans so it can be very traumatic and stressful for them to be sold to another family.
- It would be difficult to introduce a property tax in China because people feel that the government does not do enough for them. (ÖSYM)

- To make her characters memorable, the author includes many events from her own remarkable life. (ÖSYM)
- The hotel's name comes from its location near the Blue Mosque. (ÖSYM)
- Keen eyesight, an acute sense of smell and an excellent sense of hearing enable predators to track down their prey. (ÖSYM)
- The best way to use olive oil to retain its extraordinary nutritional benefits is to add it after cooking. (ÖSYM)
- The process of eating was symbolized with a man holding his hand up to his mouth. (ÖSYM)

5. Possessive Pronouns (İyelik Zamirleri)



Tanım

İyelik sıfatları gibi iyelik zamirleri de sahiplik anlatır ancak ardından isim almaz, tek başına kullanılırlar.

- ▶ You can either work in the new department or you can keep up with your current position in the company; the choice is yours.
- ▶ The opposition party declared that they would not accept the new proposed law unless the President's demands coincide with theirs.

- Two project works of my classmates / theirs haven't been accepted by our instructor as they have missed the deadline for them.
- A friend of yours is insistent on your going to her birthday party, but you don't want to go. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

'One of ...' şeklinde başlayan yapılar 'object pronoun' ile kullanılır.

- The engineering company which I work for plans to make an employee redundant from his job so one of us won't be working there next week.
- There were three people in charge of doing the accounts of the local charity and members accuse one of them of the budget deficit.

6. Reflexive Pronouns (Dönüşlü Kişi Zamirleri)



Tanım

Eylemi yapanla (özne) eylemden etkilenen (nesne) aynıysa 'reflexive pronouns' kullanılır.

- Over a short period of time, it is easy to free yourself from stresses and tensions of life and begin to unlock your body with yoga.
- One of the differences between achievers and non-achievers is the size of their dreams; to achieve a goal, a person should have confidence in himself.



Dikkat

Bir 'reflexive pronoun' hem özneyi hem de nesneyi niteleyebilir. Özneyi nitelediğinde yeri cümle içinde değişebilir, nesneyi nitelediğinde ise nesneden hemen sonra getirilir.

- Parents themselves wanted to have a talk with the headmaster.
(cümlelerin çevirisi: Veliler okul müdürüyle bizzat kendileri görüşmek istediler.)
- I would like to talk to the manager himself about a rise in my salary and I expect he will accept it.
(cümlelerin çevirisi: Maaşıma zam yapılması hakkında müdürün bizzat kendisiyle konuşmak istiyorum ve umuyorum ki bunu kabul edecek.)
- Most of the people don't care for the money itself but for the opportunities, possibilities and freedom that is offered by it.
- People who still want the pleasure of driving themselves will someday have to warn other road users that they are engaging in such a dangerous activity. (ÖSYM)



Dikkat

'Object Pronoun' ile 'reflexive pronoun' arasında kullanım farkı vardır. Bazen bir fiilden sonra her ikisi de kullanılabilir ancak anlam farklı olur. Yer veya yön bildiren bir 'preposition' dan sonra ise sadece 'object pronoun' kullanılır.

- The beautiful woman in the powder room couldn't help looking at herself / her in the mirror.
* her: another person
* herself: the beautiful woman
- After having a bad row with my boyfriend, I am trying to get over our separation and forget everything between us.
* Burada ourselves kullanılmaz.
- You see someone else scratching and soon you feel itchy yourself. (ÖSYM)
- Water shortages are not the only disasters that humans have brought on themselves, but many people also do not have access to food. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

Bir işi kendi başımıza, yardımsız (alone, without help) yaptığımızı anlatmak için 'by + reflexive pronoun' kullanılır.

- The biggest mistake of my brother's was his trying to solve all his financial problems by himself, which led him to depression at the end. (= on his own)
- My mum said she needed me to go to the shopping mall with her to buy an ironing board because it was just too big and heavy for her to carry all by herself. (= on her own)

**Dikkat**

Özne 'one' ise 'reflexive pronoun' olarak 'oneself' (bazen 'himself') kullanılır.

- One mustn't blame oneself for the things beyond control.
- * VEYA *himself*

**Dikkat**

Bazı fiiller ('help, enjoy, behave') 'reflexive pronoun' ile sıklıkla kullanılırlar.

- The students were told to behave themselves while their teacher was away.
- ('behave themselves' yapısının çevirisi: ... uslu durmaları)

**Dikkat**

'Some' ile başlayan yapılar genelde olumlu cümlelerde veya soru cümlelerinde (ikram / rica ifade eden durumlarda) kullanılır.

➤ Would you like to go somewhere quieter to discuss the topic? She suddenly felt faint and asked for something cold to drink.

➤ The management of the company doesn't meet the expectations so it's time for someone competent to take over.

➤ Our landlord wants us to move from his house to somewhere new.

**Dikkat**

'No' ile başlayan yapılar yüklemi olumlu olan cümlelerde kullanılır ancak anlamı olumsuzlaştırırlar.

➤ Jane finally understood that she had no one but herself to count on.
(cümlelerin çevirisi: Jane kendinden başka güvenecek hiç kimse olmadığını en sonunda anladı.)

➤ Nobody in the classroom is satisfied with the presentation style of the subjects.
* 'isn't satisfied' denmez.

➤ I had to stand up during the seminar as there was nowhere for me to sit.
* 'wasn't' denmez.

➤ The doctor says there has been nothing wrong with my blood pressure and tension so far.
* 'hasn't been' denmez.

➤ As far as I understand, nobody is happy with their salaries and working conditions in the company. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

Aynı cümle içinde kullanıldıklarında 'no' ile başlayan bir yapıyı ya da olumsuz anlam taşıyan kelimeleri 'any' ile başlayan bir yapı takip etmelidir.

- I was exhausted when I came home yesterday so I did barely anything to finish my term project.
- Nobody at the office knows anything about the deployment of our colleague.
- Without any distractions, I can't seem to focus intensely on anything for more than half an hour. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

'Any' ile başlayan yapılar olumsuz ve soru cümlelerinde kullanıldıklarında 'hiç' anlamına gelirler. Olumsuz cümlelerde cümle başında özne olarak bulunamazlar.

- The child was in great despair after her parents' death in the war as she didn't have anywhere to go.
- There's never been anything worth bothering myself except for not being able to pass the driving test.
- Has anyone seen you enter the restricted area without the chef's permission? If he has, you will be in big trouble.

**Dikkat**

'Any' ile başlayan yapılar olumlu cümleyle de kullanılabilir. Bu durumda 'her', 'herhangi' anlamına gelirler ve cümle başında özne olarak kullanılabilirler.

- Anybody having a little knowledge about the subject can see that something is wrong with the essay.
- You have deserved a nice holiday after working for a long time. You can go anywhere you like; your tickets are on the house.
- As far as I'm concerned, anyone in the society is liable for both the corruption and the advancement of it.
- Anything that might be of help should be used so as to solve the problem.
- Young people's belief that they can do almost anything has not changed. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

'Every' ile başlayan yapılar Türkçe'ye "herkes, her yer, her şey" şeklinde çevrilebilir.

- The plan was approved by everybody in the department; however, the board members didn't lean towards it.
- An ordinance which was adopted in February 2006 banned smoking everywhere in the city except on private residential property.
- With the advent of computers, graphics tablets, and digital cameras, the term image editing encompasses everything that can be done to a photo.
- Everyone knows that elderly people hear less well than young people and that men hear less well than women.

**Dikkat**

Soru sözcüklerinden, bazı zamirlerden ve sıfatlardan sonra "daha, başka, ayrıca" anlamlarını vermek için 'else' kullanılır.

- In achieving happiness, relationship is more important than anything else in the World.
(*'anything else' yapısının çevirisi: ... başka herhangi bir şey*)
- Nothing else has been talked about the project other than whether it is applicable or not.
(*'nothing else' yapısının çevirisi: ... başka hiçbir şey*)
- People who keep looking for someone else's mistakes are actually full of mistakes themselves.
(*'someone else' yapısının çevirisi: ... başka biri*)
- What else has changed in the production department of the company?
(*'what else' yapısının çevirisi: ... başka ne*)

- Couples should care for each other by meeting one another's emotional needs thereby taking advantage of a happy marriage.
(*'each other' yapısının çevirisi: ... birbirlerine / 'one another's' yapısının çevirisi: ... birbirlerinin*)
- As soon as the snow melts, the wild vegetables begin to sprout as if competing with one another.
(*'one another' yapısının çevirisi: ... birbirleriyle*)
- Because Thailand and Indonesia are geographically close to each other in East Asia, they can easily trade with each other. (ÖSYM)
(*'each other' yapısının çevirisi: ... birbirlerine / birbirleriyle*)
- Nearly all of the tourist sites in Sultanahmet are located close to each other. (2012 LYS)

9. Impersonal Pronoun: One



Tanım

'One', kişi, insan anlamında kullanılabilir.

- One must deal with various pleasant or unpleasant circumstances while getting work experience.
- Most of the religions teach one what to do yet yoga teaches one just how to be.



Dikkat

'One' bir ismin yerini de tutabilir.

- There are a number of chocolates in the store but I prefer the ones with cream fillings.
- My friend is going to organize a big festival and I think it will be greater than the first one.
- I've interviewed many businessmen, and you're one of the most successful ones. (ÖSYM)

- Although the population of Bangladesh is slightly larger than that of Pakistan, its land area is much smaller. (ÖSYM)
- When walking in a group, the walking pace should be that of the slowest member so that he or she does not feel left behind. (ÖSYM)
- Wi-Fi is based on radio waves whose frequency is similar to that of microwaves. (ÖSYM)

Another: 'Aynı türden bir tane daha' ya da 'başka (bir)' anlamını vermek için kullanılır. Sıfat olarak kullanıldığında ardından 'tekil isim' alır.

- I couldn't take the chance of getting promoted last year and now I wish I had another.
- Italian Prime Minister Silvio Berlusconi has said he needs another five years to bring Italy from the Middle Ages into the modern world.
* Bu cümlede 'five years' tek bir birim olarak alınmış ve 'bir beş yıl daha' anlamında kullanılmıştır.
- Steps and patterns are passed on from one generation to another, gradually undergoing a process of change. (ÖSYM)
- Tribal histories, traditions and customs would be lost forever if they were not passed down orally from one generation to another. (ÖSYM)
- ... Hieroglyphs are also used as phonetic signs representing the whole or part of a word. Another function of the hieroglyphs was to decorate important buildings and sculptures. (ÖSYM)

Other (Sıfat) / Others (Zamir): Bu yapılar "başka, başkası, diğerleri" şeklinde Türkçe'ye çevrilebilir.

- Most birds, as well as other wild animals, have become extinct due to habitat loss and destruction by us.
('other' yapısının çevirisi: ... başka)
- The findings could explain why some heavy drinkers and smokers live to a ripe old age while others have their lives cut short by their habits.
('others' yapısının çevirisi: ... diğerleri)
- Some students, even the weak ones, can learn vocabulary, but others can't and don't want to learn grammar, because it seems boring to them.
- Steps and patterns are passed on from one generation to another, gradually undergoing a process of change. (ÖSYM)
- Passing on knowledge to others was once thought to be a uniquely human ability, but several species are proving otherwise. (ÖSYM)
- Democracies and authoritarian regimes tend to deal with identity conflicts, as with most other matters, in different ways. (ÖSYM)
- While some scholars feel that this may be somewhat ambiguous, there is a general agreement on some other issues. (ÖSYM)
- Rice yielded more than other early domesticated grains like wheat and barley. (ÖSYM)
- Many say one member's behaviour or experience in a team leads to changes in others' performances. (ÖSYM)

**Dikkat**

'Other(s)', 'some, any, no, many' gibi yapılarla da kullanılabilir.

- Inhaling acrylic paint or any other kind of paint makes one lose his brain cells so it should be strictly avoided.
- Every year, thousands of children are rushed to casualty because they've swallowed cleaning fluid, weed killer or some other poisons.
